

**SENSE OF THE BOARD RESOLUTION
CONGRATULATING KEYARA ZAMOR ON
USING CPR TRAINING TO SAVE HER YOUNG COUSIN**

WHEREAS, Jonathan George survived a fall into a backyard pond during a family gathering due to the quick response of his cousin, Keyara Zamor; and

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2017, Keyara Zamor's cousin, Jonathan George, fell into a backyard fish pond at her uncle's house in Bay Shore, NY, and

WHEREAS, Keyara Zamor pulled him out of the water and administered CPR for about ten minutes until first responders arrived; and

WHEREAS, because of the prompt response of Keyara Zamor, Jonathan George survived his fall into the pond; and

WHEREAS, Keyara Zamor, a student at AITE in Stamford, attended a Hands for Life CPR training event two years ago, using these skills for the first time when she saved her cousin's life; and

WHEREAS, Keyara Zamor said she remembered what she learned at her CPR training and was able to act quickly to save her cousin; and

WHEREAS, Keyara Zamor was presented with a proclamation from Mayor Martin at a ceremony in the Stamford Government Center, where the Mayor was joined by several city and school officials, and the founder of Hands for Life CPR, in congratulating Keyara Zamor on her heroic actions; and

WHEREAS, Keyara Zamor has encouraged her family and friends to take CPR training.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the 29th Board of Representatives recognizes Keyara Zamor for her prompt response and thanks her for saving the life of her cousin, Jonathan George.
