

**SENSE OF THE BOARD RESOLUTION
CONGRATULATING MIKE WALSH ON HIS RETIREMENT
AFTER 39 YEARS OF COACHING THE TRINITY CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL
BOYS BASKETBALL PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Mike Walsh has retired after 39 years as coach of the Trinity Catholic Boy Basketball Program; and

WHEREAS, Mike Walsh began his coaching career with Trinity in 1973 as an assistant coach in basketball and baseball and became head varsity basketball coach in 1979; and

WHEREAS, under Mike Walsh's coaching, Trinity teams reached the FCIAC finals 12 times, winning 6 FCIAC titles, and reached the state final 13 times, winning 7 state championships; and

WHEREAS, Mike Walsh retired with 633 wins, the fourth most in State history; and

WHEREAS, in 2011, Mike Walsh received the Gold Key award from the Connecticut Sports Writers' Alliance, which recognizes Connecticut individuals who have achieved excellence on the youth, high school, college and professional levels

WHEREAS, Mike Walsh has dedicated his career to the development of his players as people, steering them and helping them grow into successful young men; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the 30th Stamford Board of Representatives extends their sincere thanks and appreciation to Mike Walsh on 39 years as coach of the Trinity Catholic Boy Basketball Program and congratulates him on his retirement.
