## SENSE OF THE BOARD RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE CONNECTICUT DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, THE STAMFORD POLICE DEPARTMENT, THE STAMFORD DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, TRAFFIC AND PARKING, DIRECTOR TED JANKOWSKI, O&G INDUSTRIES AND THE VARIOUS SUBCONTRACTORS THAT WORKED ON THIS PROJECT AND THE CONNECTICUT STATE POLICE ON THEIR EXCELLENT COMMUNICATION AND WORK ON THE REPLACEMENT OF THE ROUTE 1 BRIDGE OVER EXIT 9 OF I-95.

**WHEREAS,** the replacement of the Route 1 bridge over Exit 9 of I-95 was completed on June 9, 2019 and required the closure of I-95 and the Route 1 bridge between Courtland Avenue and Seaside Avenue on two separate weekends; and

**WHEREAS,** the Stamford Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking worked tirelessly to coordinate the logistics for the Exit 9 Route 1 Bridge Replacement; and

WHEREAS, Director Jankowski continuously monitored the situation during the road closure and the various police departments were present, coordinated with each other and provided continuous assistance to residents; and

**WHEREAS,** the extensive communication and coordination of all of these parties ensured that delays on I-95 and Stamford side roads were minimal.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the 30th Board of Representatives that it thanks the Connecticut Department Of Transportation, the Stamford Police Department, the Stamford Department of Transportation, Traffic and Parking, Director Ted Jankowski, O&G Industries and The Various Subcontractors That Worked On This Project and The Connecticut State Police for its superior communications and coordination to ensure that this project was carried out smoothly.
