1. P30.055 REJECTION; Agreement between City of Stamford and Municipal Nurses Association 08/05/20 – Submitted by Al Cava 08/10/20 – To be Considered by Board of Finance

Mr. Cava explained that the agreement provides for a 0% salary increase for FY19-20 with a reopener for FY20-21, resulting in a savings of \$121,906, and migration to the State Partnership plan, resulting in a savings of \$51,000. The agreement also contains a no layoff clause and a \$500 lump sum payment to the 13 employees who have volunteered to do Covid-19 testing. The 3 members who were laid off will be reinstated.

A motion to reject Item No. 1 was made, seconded and failed by a vote of 0-32-0 (Reps. Adams, Aquila, Coleman, Cottrell, Curtis, de la Cruz, Di Costanzo, Fedeli, Figueroa, Florio, Giordano, Jacobson, Lee, Liebson, Lion, Matherne, McMullen, Michelson, Miller, Moore, Morson, Nabel, Palomba, Patterson, Policar, Quinones, Sherwood, Summerville, Wallace, Watkins and Zelinsky opposed).
