

**SENSE OF THE BOARD RESOLUTION
HONORING DR. TAMU LUCERO FOR HER 13 YEARS OF
SERVICE WITH STAMFORD PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

WHEREAS, Dr. Tamu Lucero joined Stamford Public Schools as Assistant Superintendent, Elementary Schools in June of 2013; became Deputy Superintendent in June of 2018 and was unanimously appointed Superintendent in April 2019; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Tamu Lucero is leaving Stamford to embark on an exciting career opportunity in international education; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Lucero's many significant accomplishments during her 7-year tenure as Superintendent include the first comprehensive curriculum audit in over 20 years, strengthening district safety and security, expanding supports and services for multilingual learners and their families, expanding programs for students with disabilities, collaborating with the City of Stamford to develop a long-term facilities plan, and working with the City of Stamford and the Stamford Delegation to secure historic construction reimbursement from the State; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Lucero is a tireless proponent of Stamford Public Schools, vigorously advocating for fiscally sound budgets that provide adequate resources for every student, is a regular visitor to every school during both during the instructional day and for extracurricular events such as performing arts and sports events; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Lucero also generously volunteered her time to the Stamford community serving on many boards, including the Ferguson Library, SoundWaters, The Avon Theatre, Building One Community, Horizons at New Canaan Country School, the United Way's Cradle-to-Career Program and the Bartlett Arboretum; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Lucero is first committed to ensuring that every single student succeeds. Serving as Stamford's Superintendent was Dr. Lucero's passion, and she leaves a legacy that will benefit Stamford Public Schools for decades to come—from gold-standard PreK-12 curricula across all content areas and the expansion of college preparatory and career and technical education programs, to new and renovated buildings to support 21st century learning.
