I attach with this letter the approved DSSD budget for the tax year 2015/2016 which reflects \$2,156,720 of Special Assessment income.

The final DSSD Grand List of October 2014 supplied by Greg Stackpole on May 6, 2015 totals \$1,474,628,876 Net Taxable Assessed Value. After adding Net Taxable Assessed Value of \$88,212,010 for UBS buildings that are billed directly by the DSSD as per contract, the adjusted DSSD Net Taxable Grand List totals \$1,562,840,886. Therefore, the DSSD special assessment levy should be set at 1.38 mills to achieve the assessment income of \$2,156,720.

Please use the 1.38 mill rate for the July 2015 and January 2016 DSSD tax bills.
