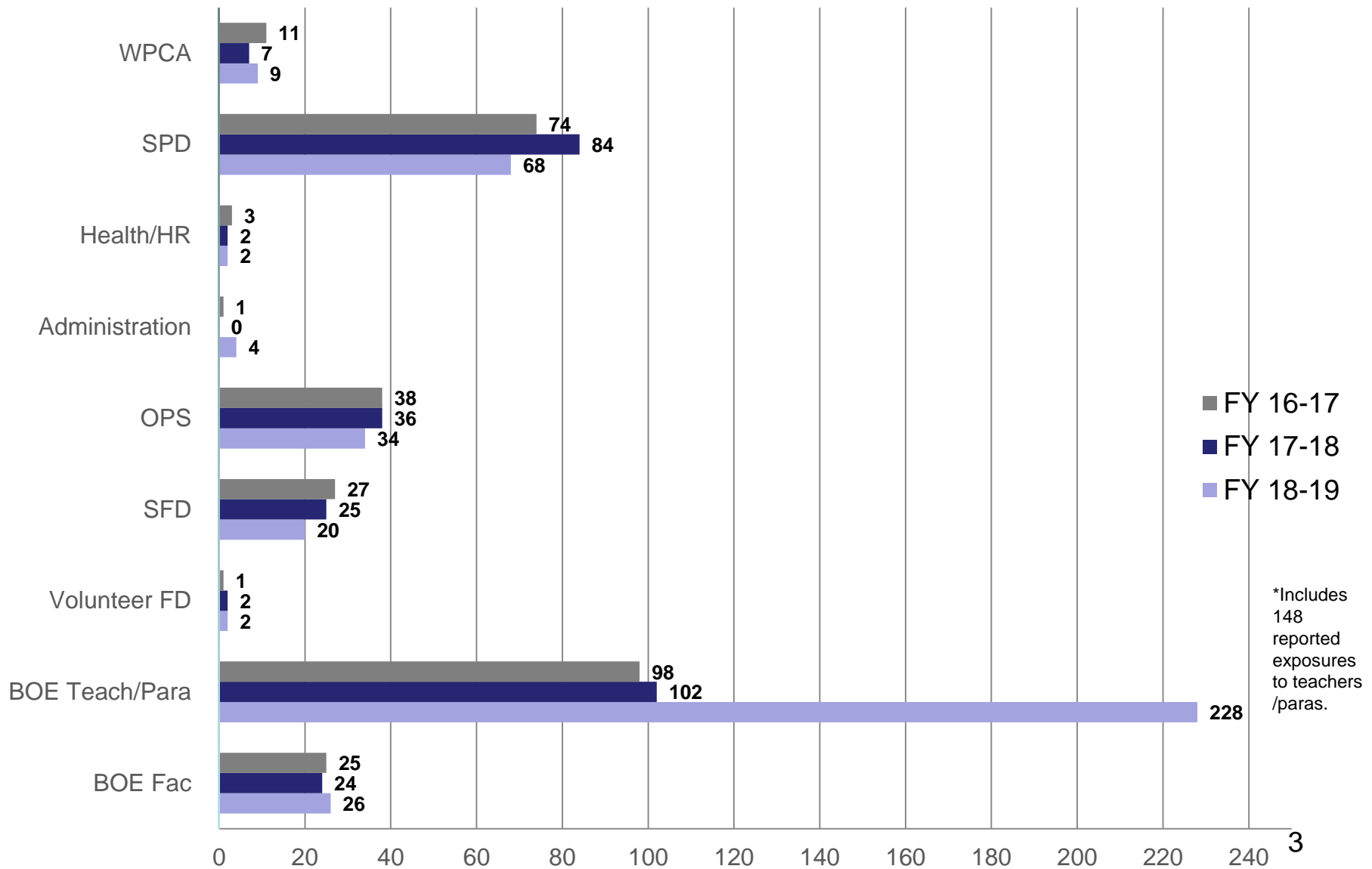

BOE Reported Mold Exposures

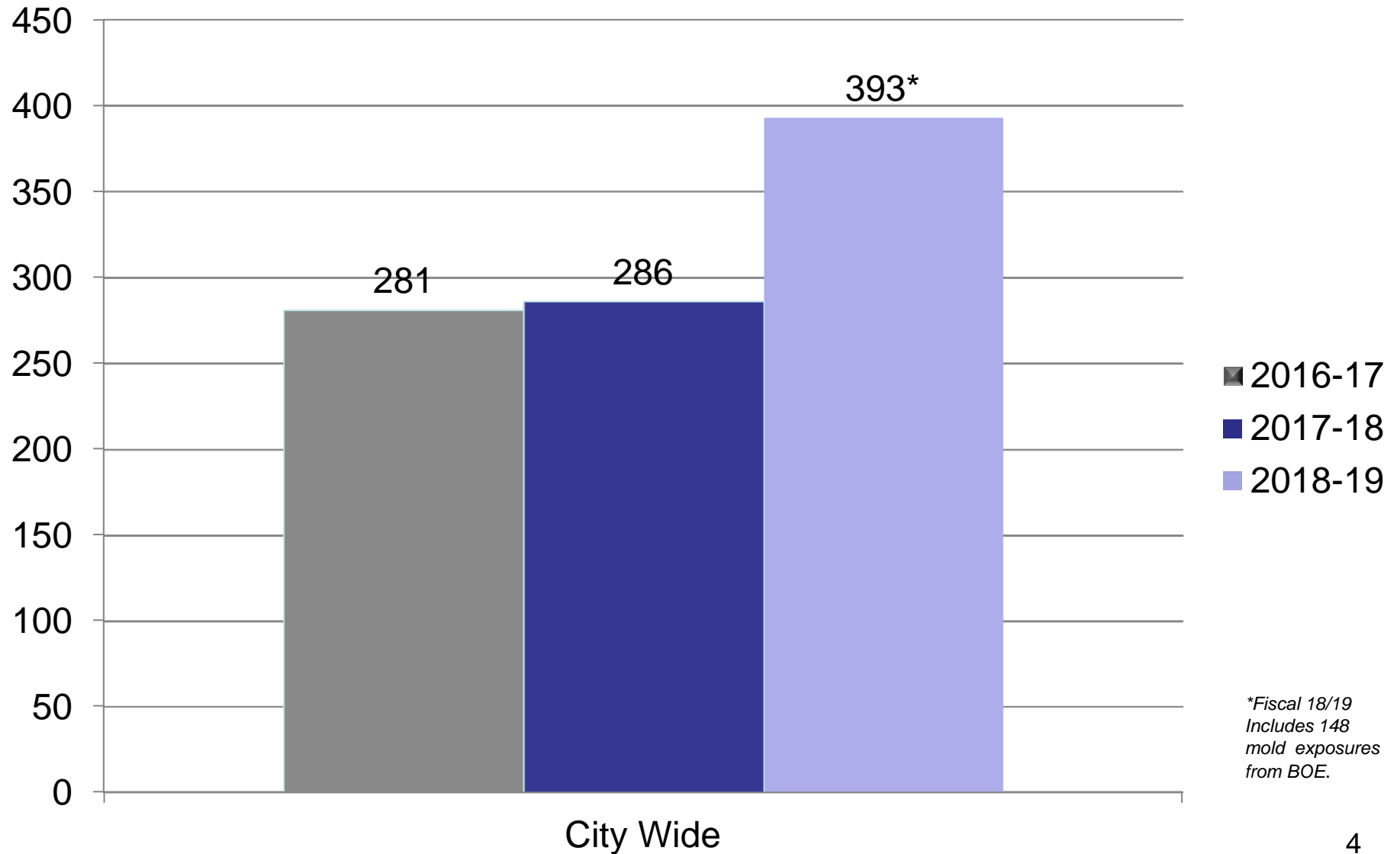
The Board of Education has had a number of employee injury reports filled out due to the presence of reported mold exposures in some of our schools.

We have had a total of 148 reported exposures in fiscal 2018/2019, representing 38% of all claims within the city. The exposures will be reflected in various slides in the following presentation.

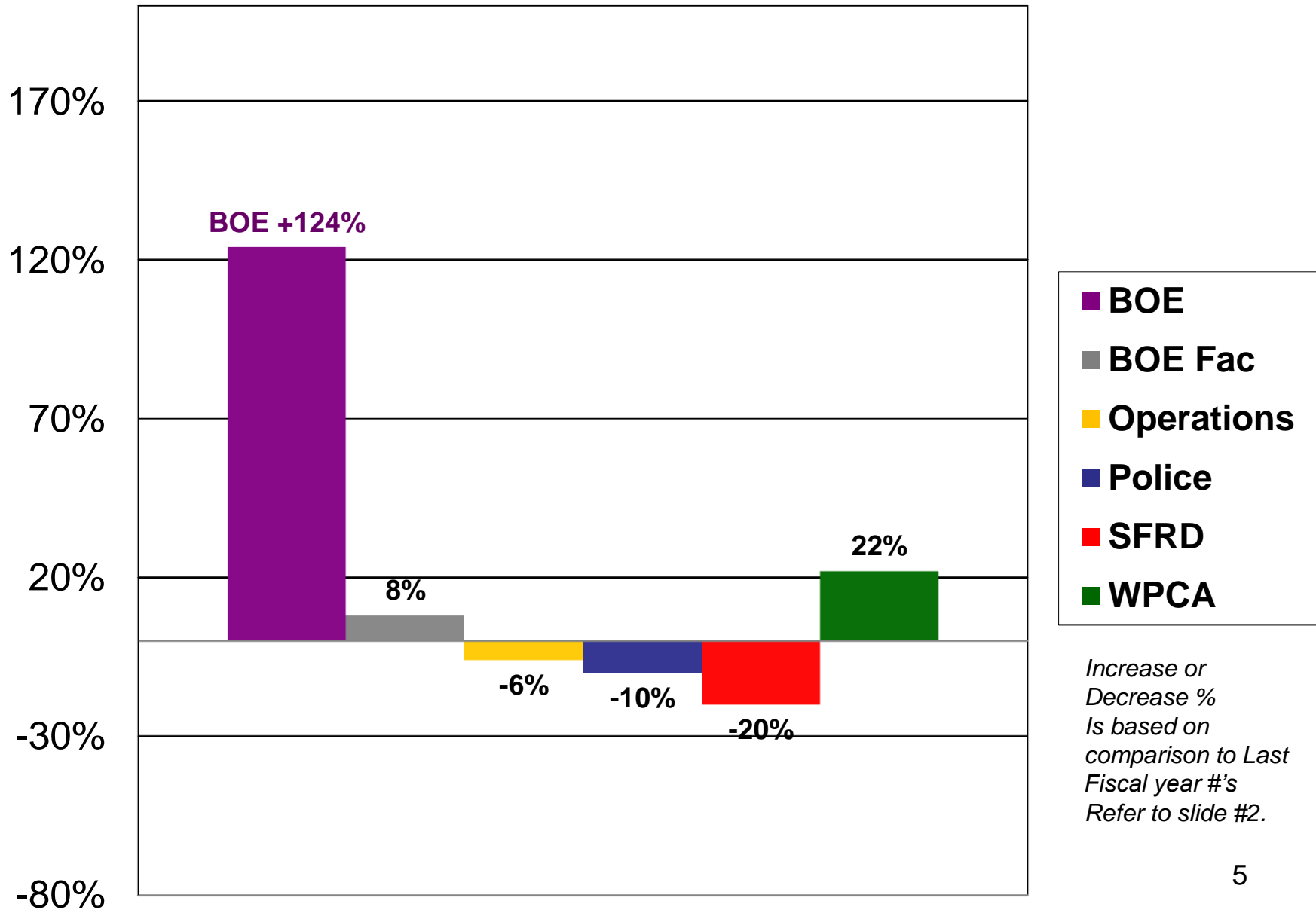
3 Year *Fiscal* Comparison by Dept.



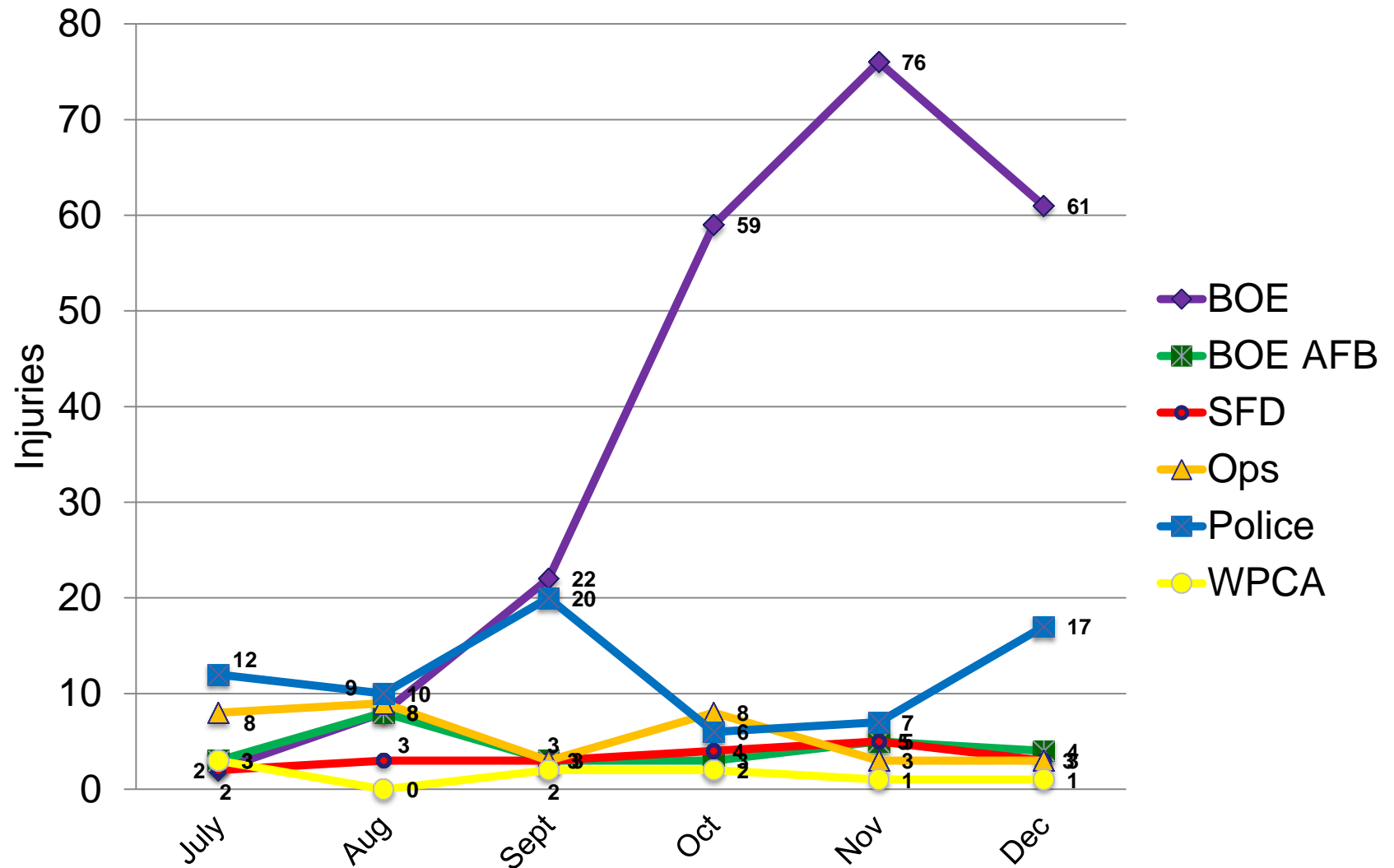
3 Year Comparison Total Claims *Fiscal*



Fiscal Claim performance 17-18 vs. 18-19

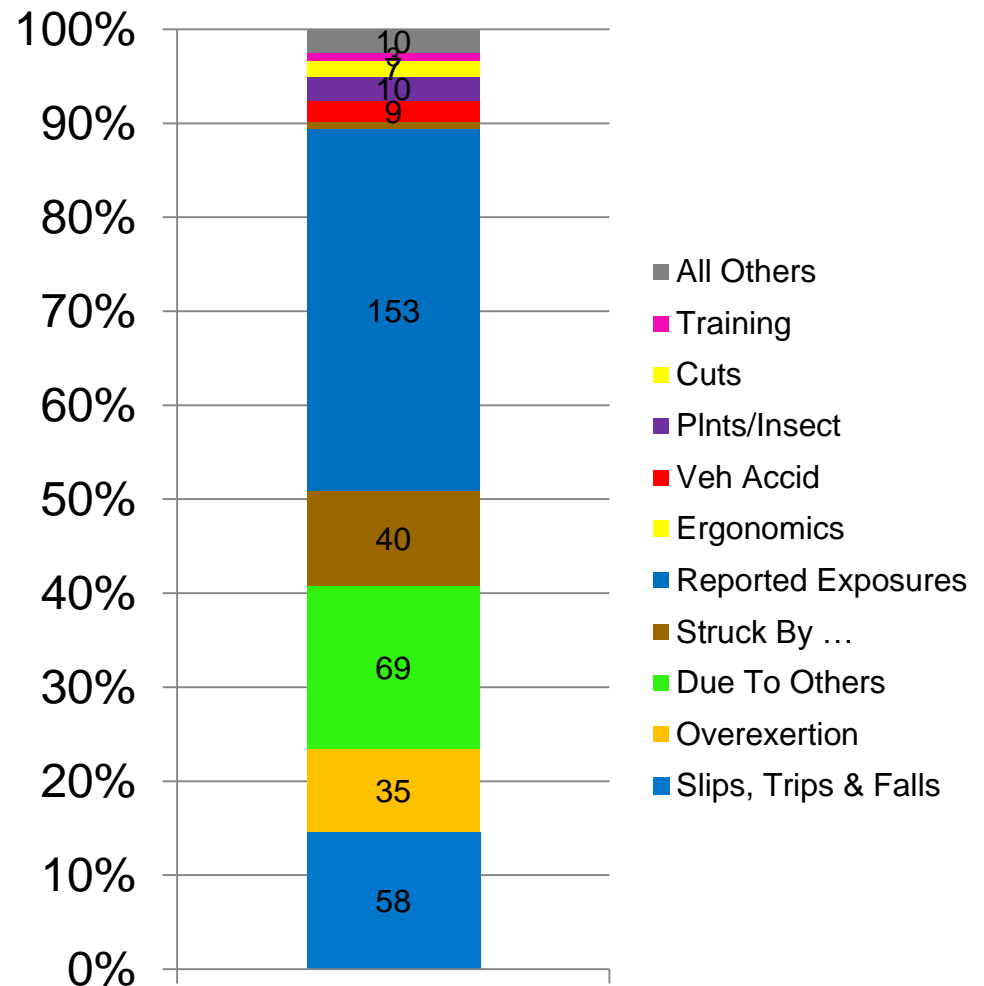


Fiscal year analysis claims by month

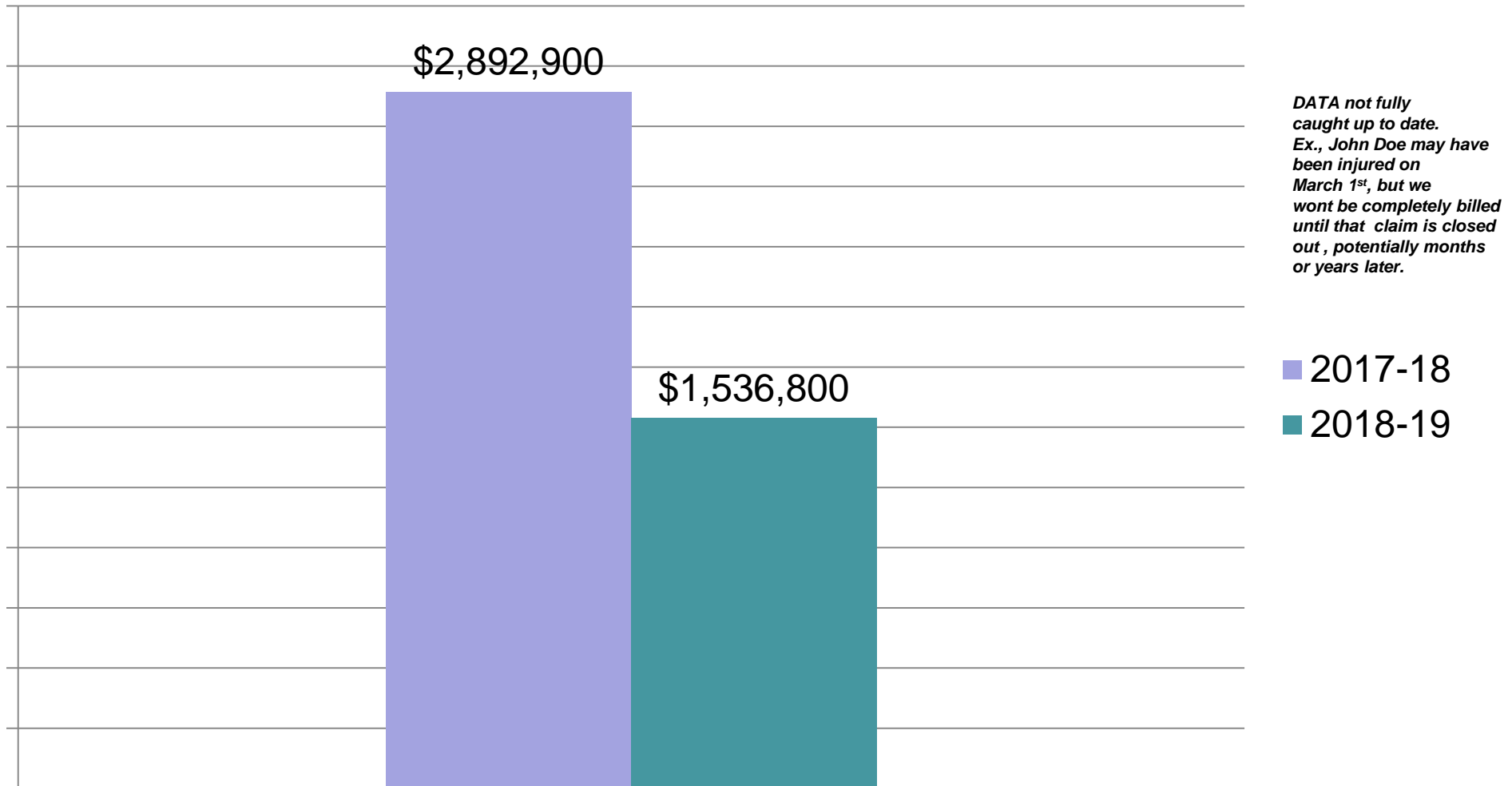


Top 4 Leading Causes of Claims FY 2018/19

Type	# of Incidents	% of Total
›Reported Exposures (BOE, Police, Fire where there is reported exposure with Blood/or other pathogen. BOE is Mold related and is 97% of total exposures 18/19)	153	39%
›Due To Others (Caused by others, combative subject, violence, Police/BOE)	69	17%
›Slip, Trip, & Falls (All ice, wet, objects, stairs, ladders, etc.)	58	15%
›Overexertion (all lifting, bending/twisting, push/pull, strain)	40	10%

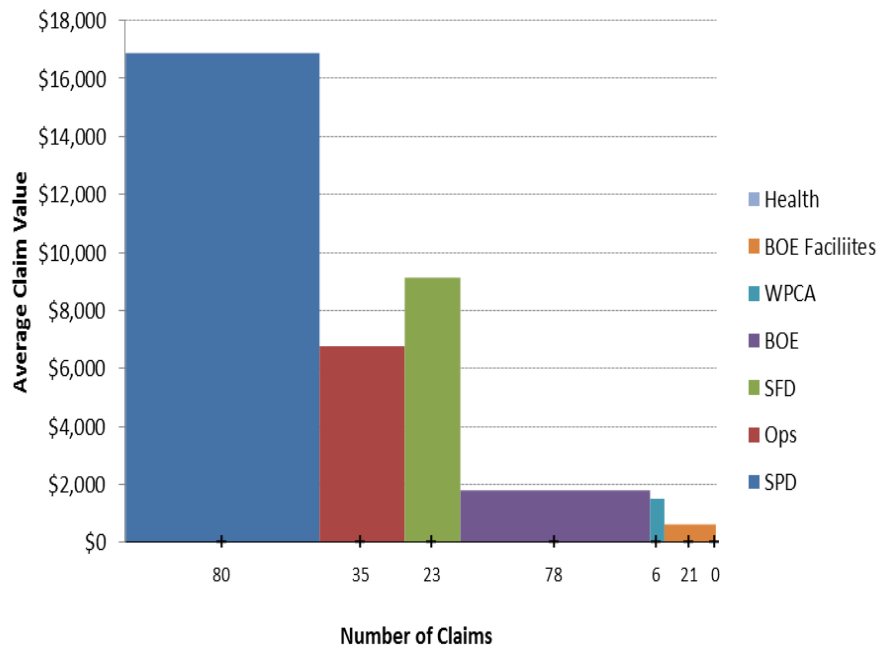


•Fiscal 2 Year Cost Comparison

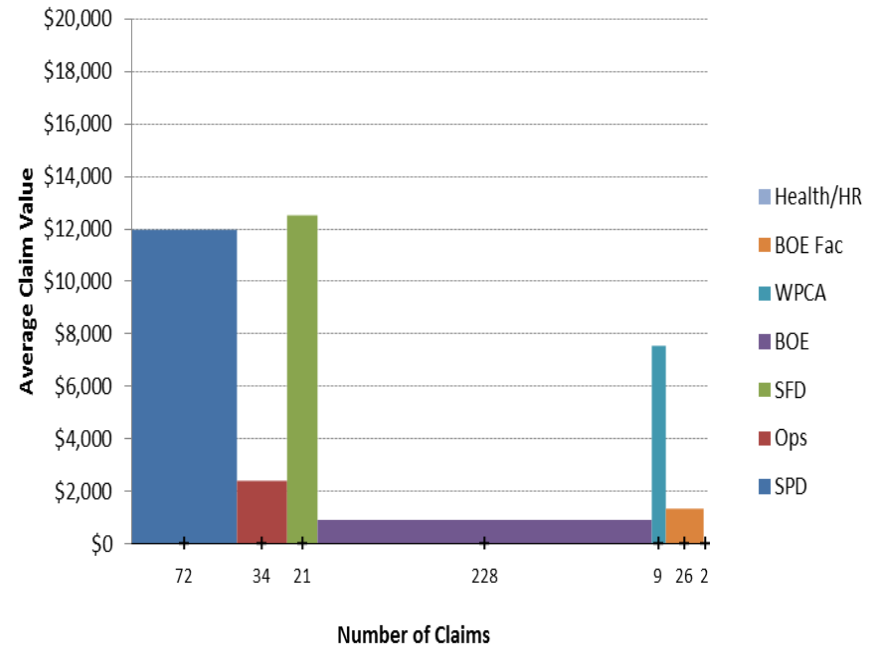


Average Claim severity Fiscal comparison last two years

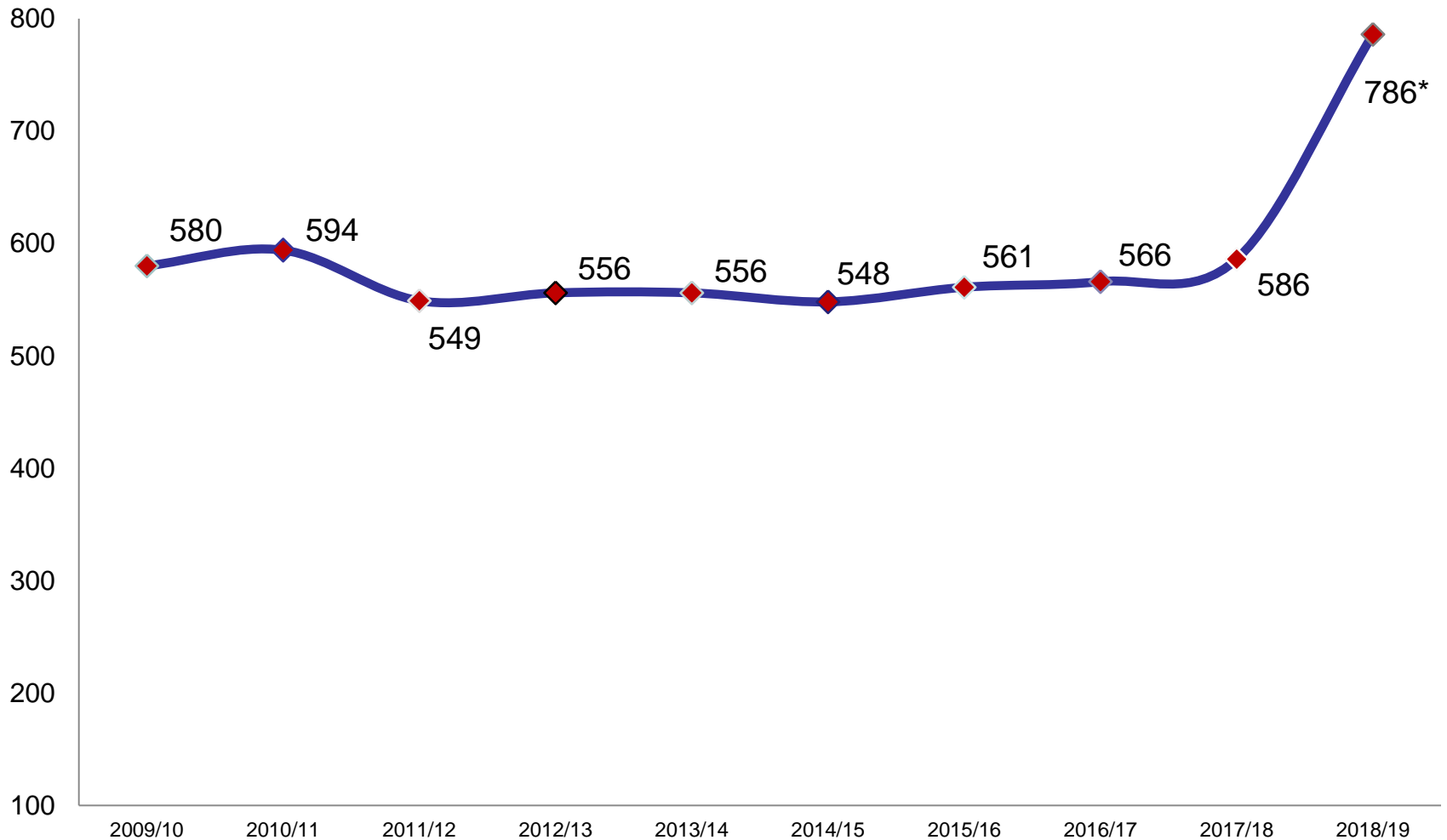
Claims FY17/18



Claims FY 18/19

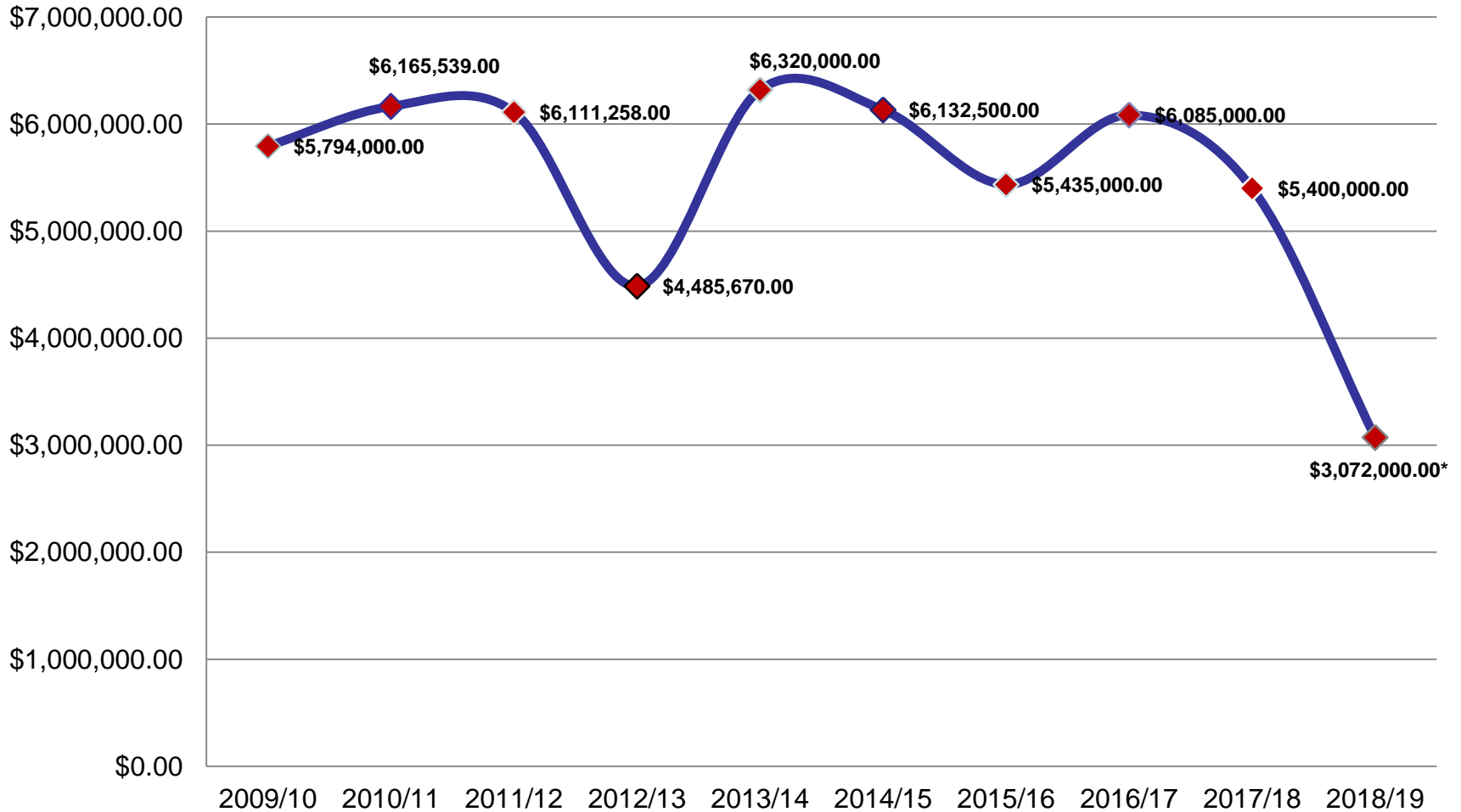


10 yr. Claim Comparison



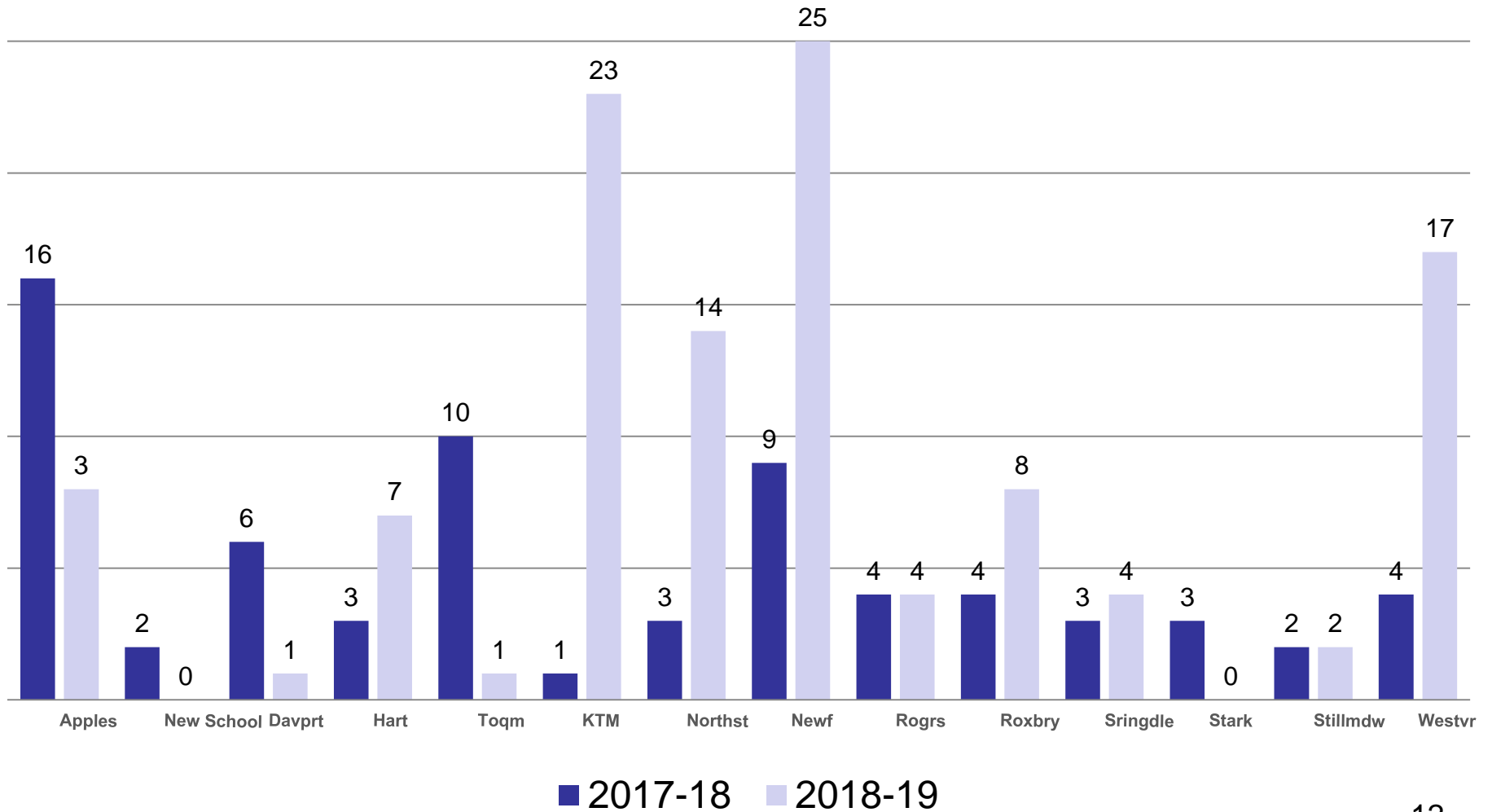

10 yr. Dollar Comparison

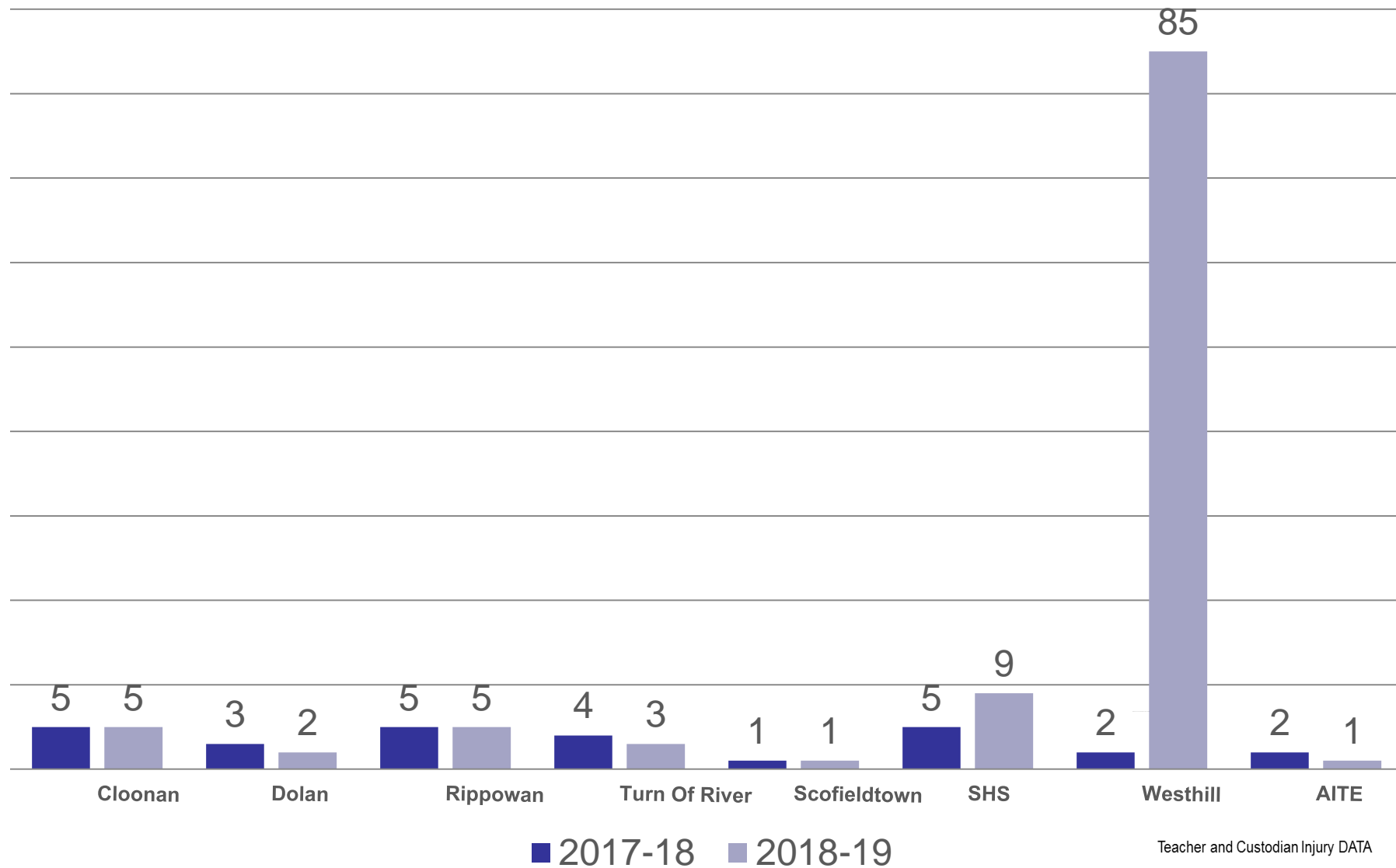

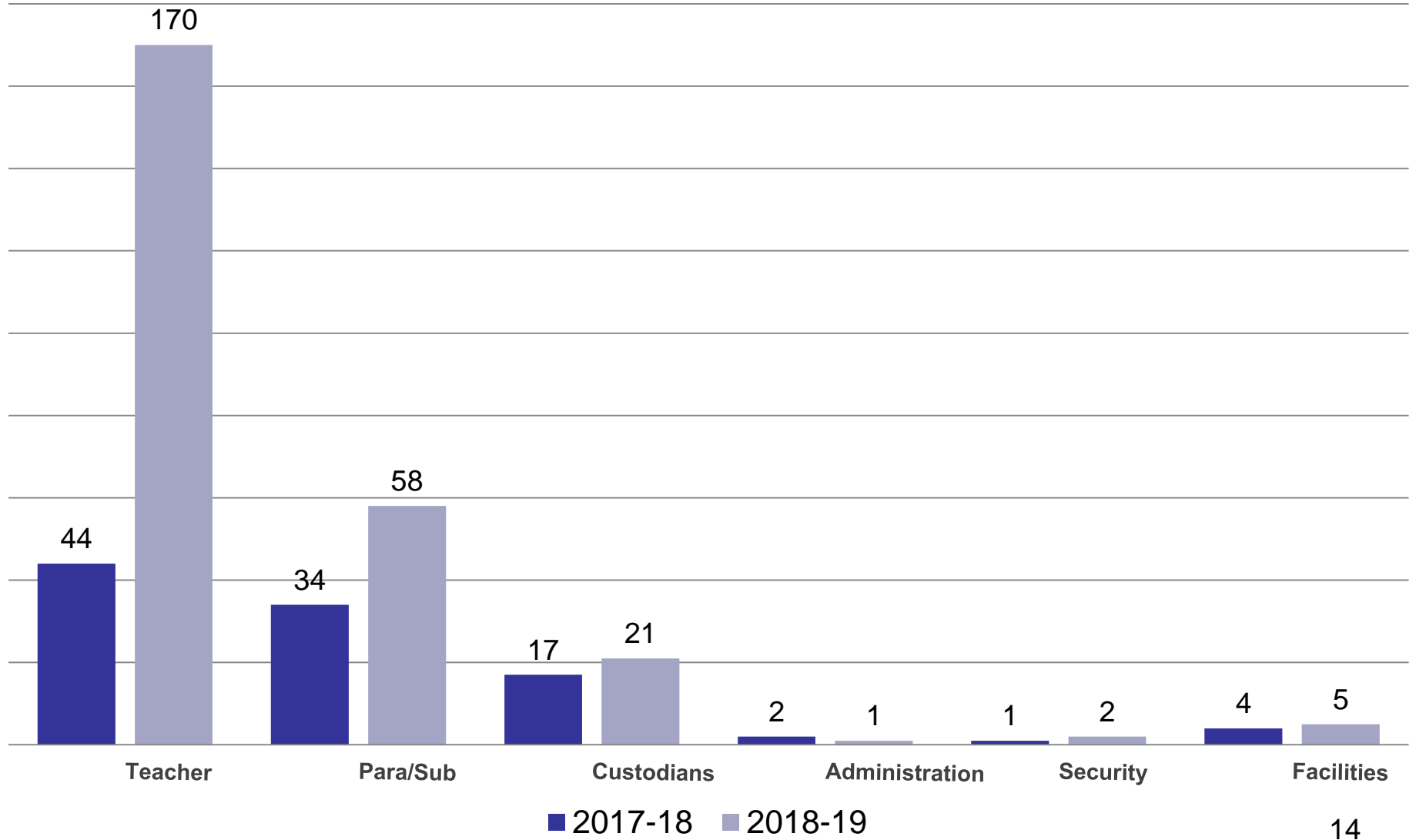
BOE *Elementary* Schools YTD Incident Comparison



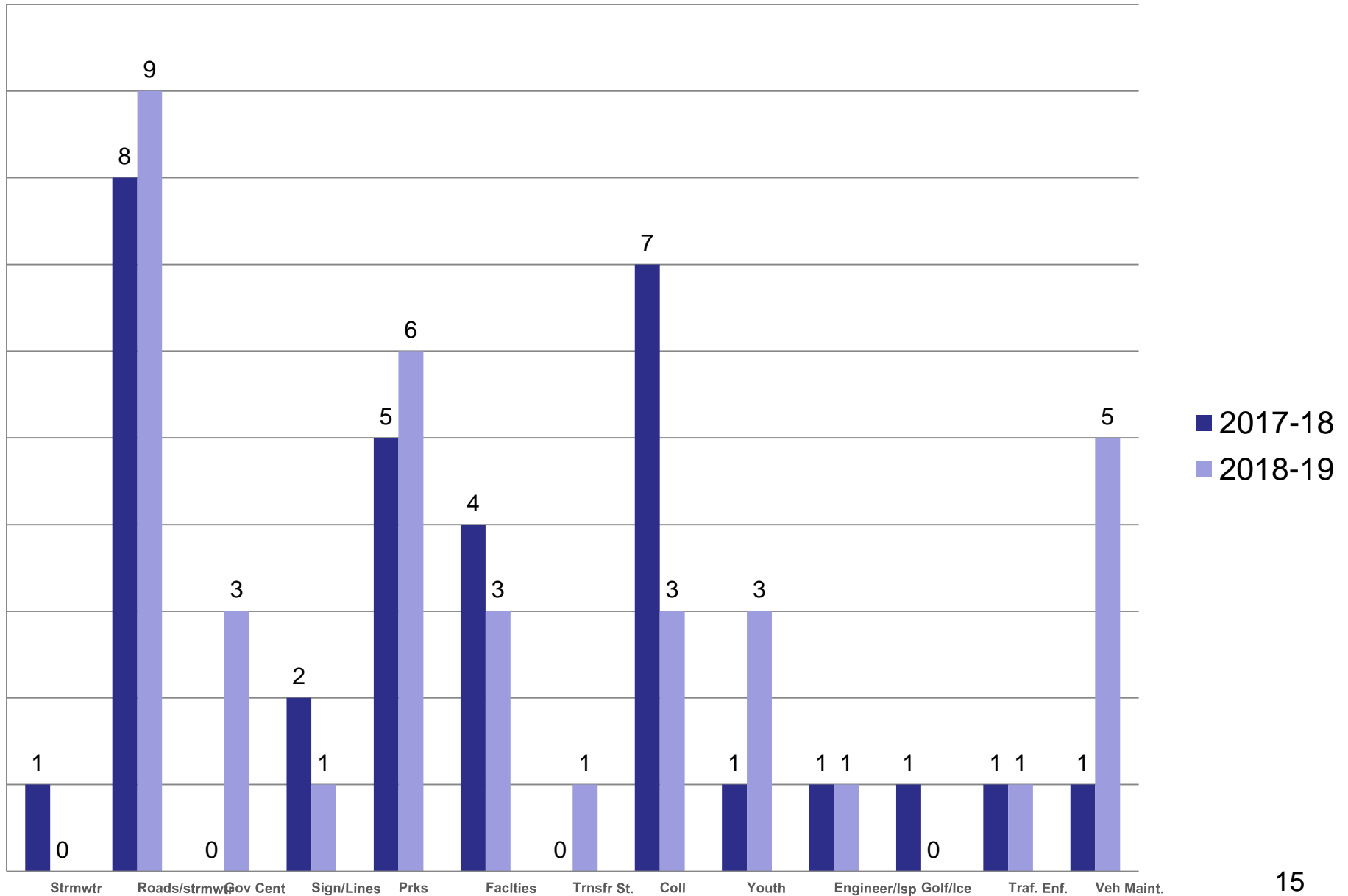
BOE Middle & High Schools YTD Incident Comparison

Operations YTD Incident Comparison

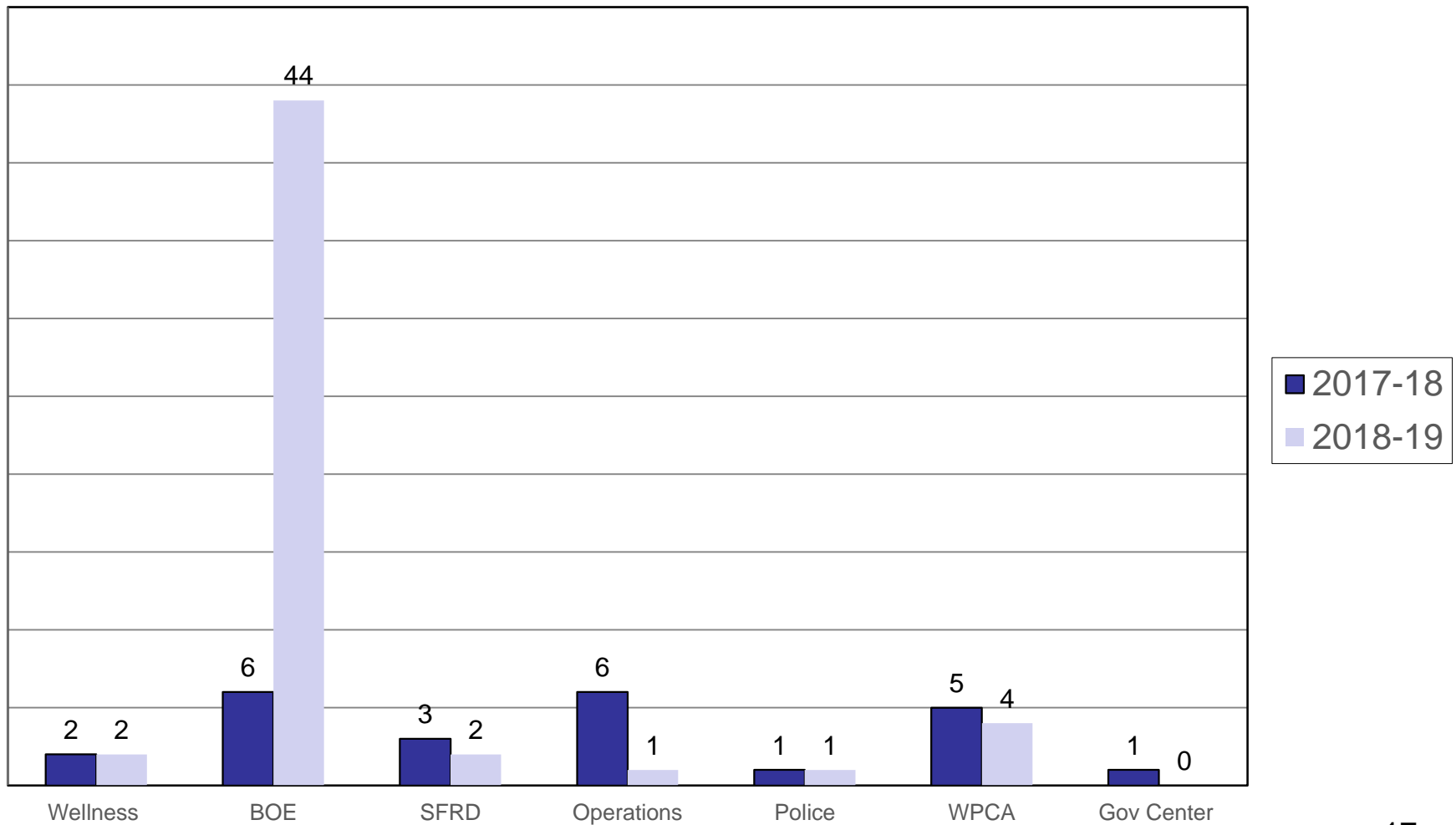

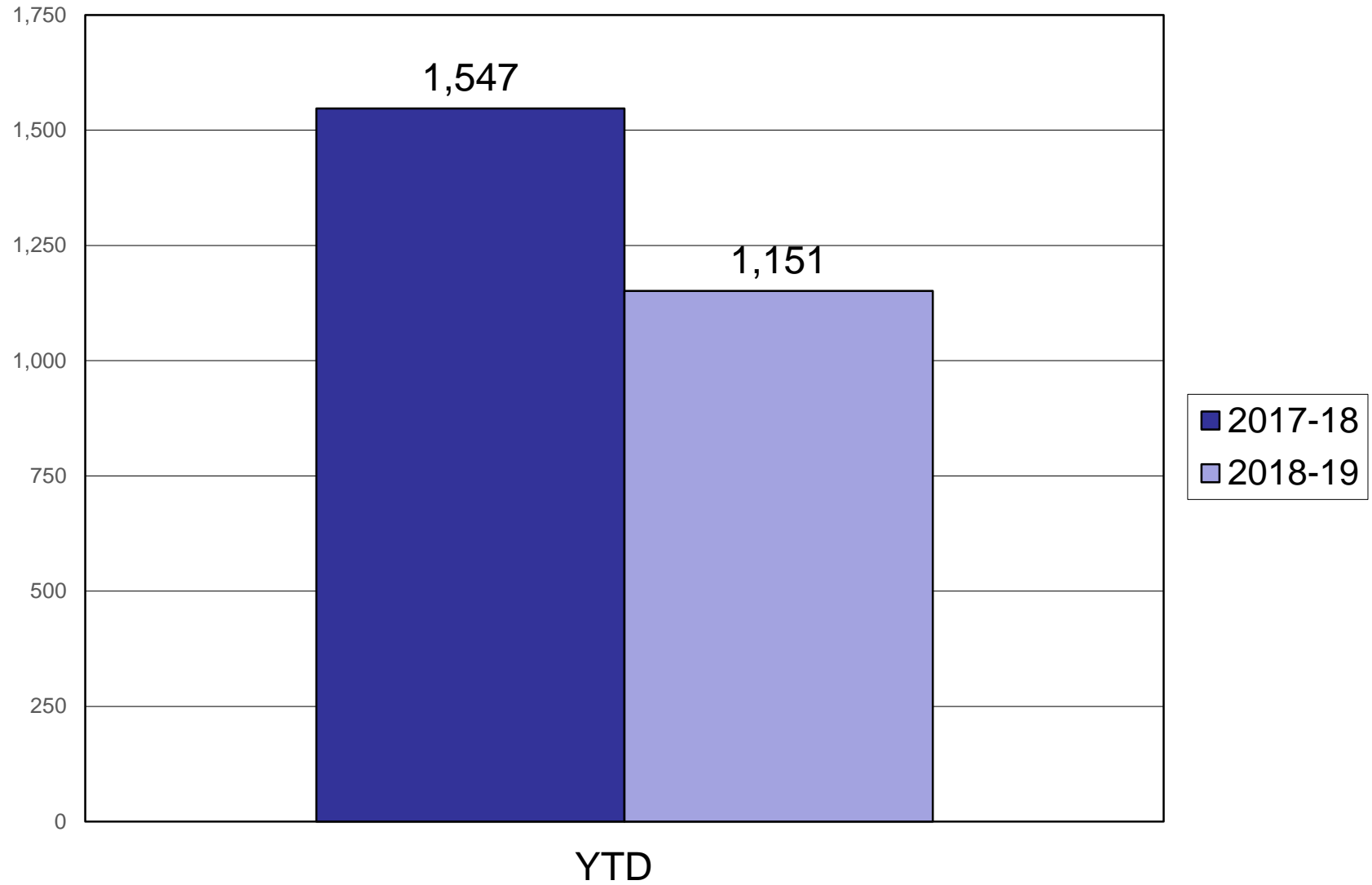
