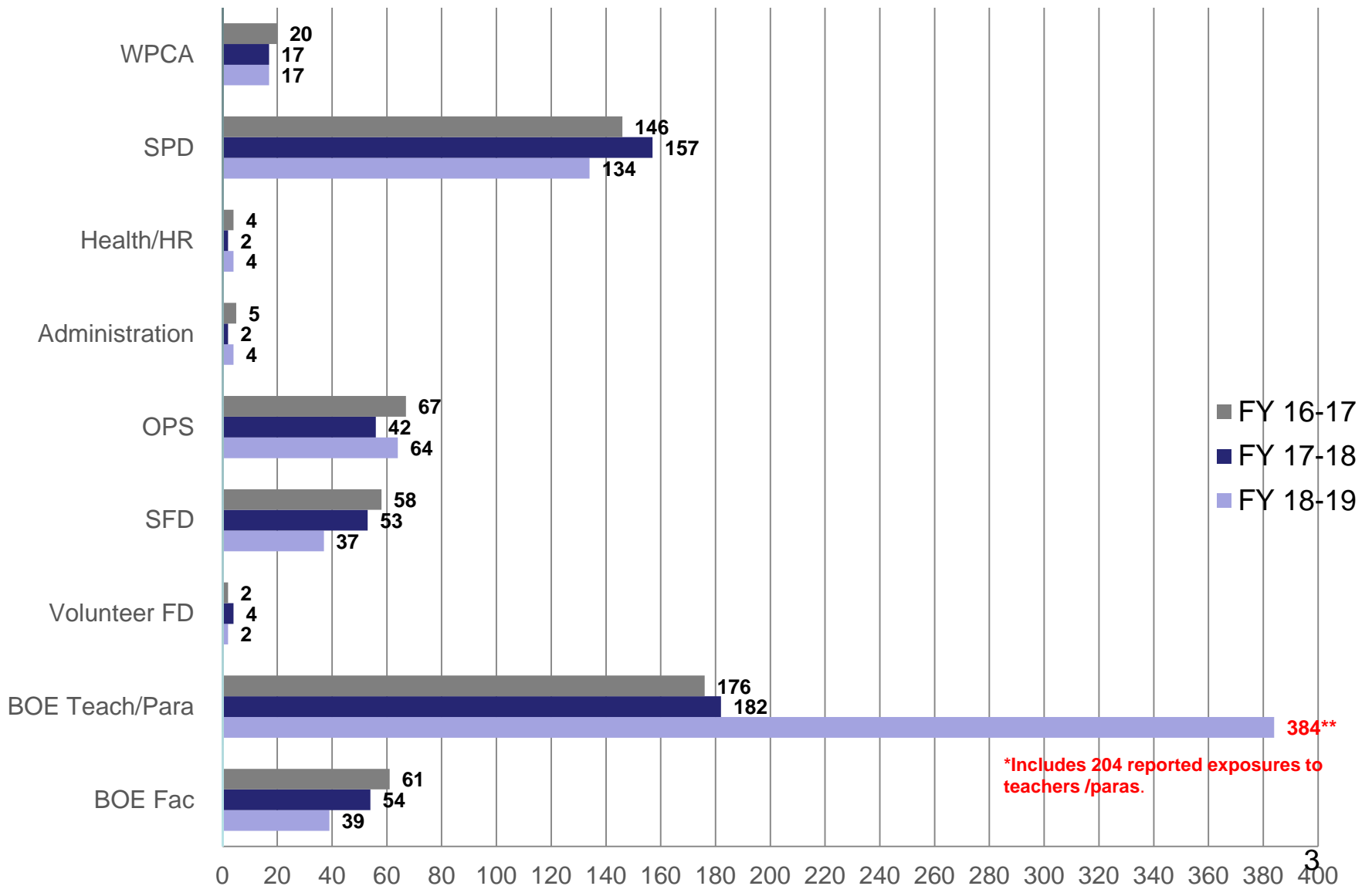

# BOE Reported Mold Exposures

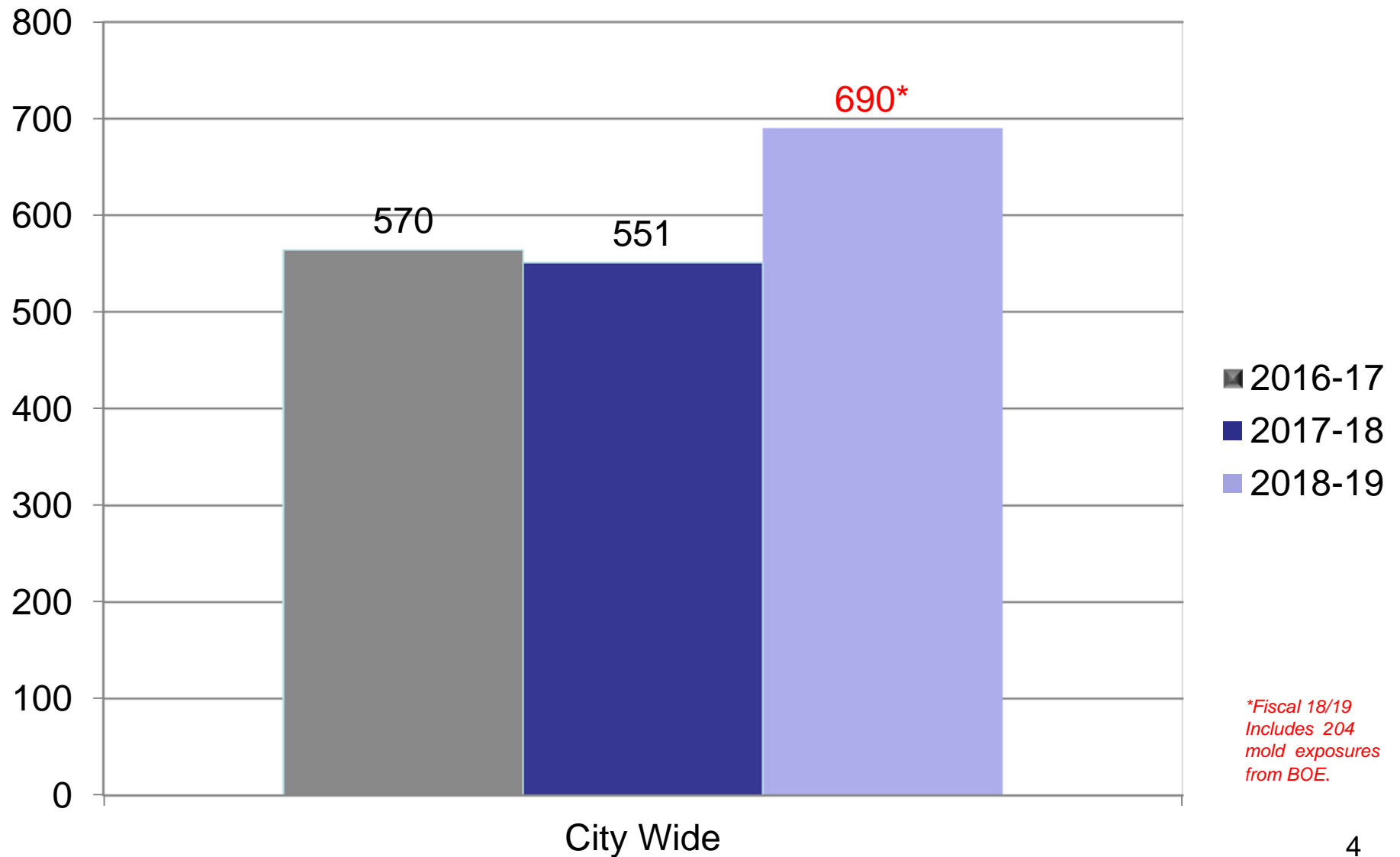
*The Board of Education has had a number of employee injury reports filled out due to the presence of reported mold exposures in some of our schools.*

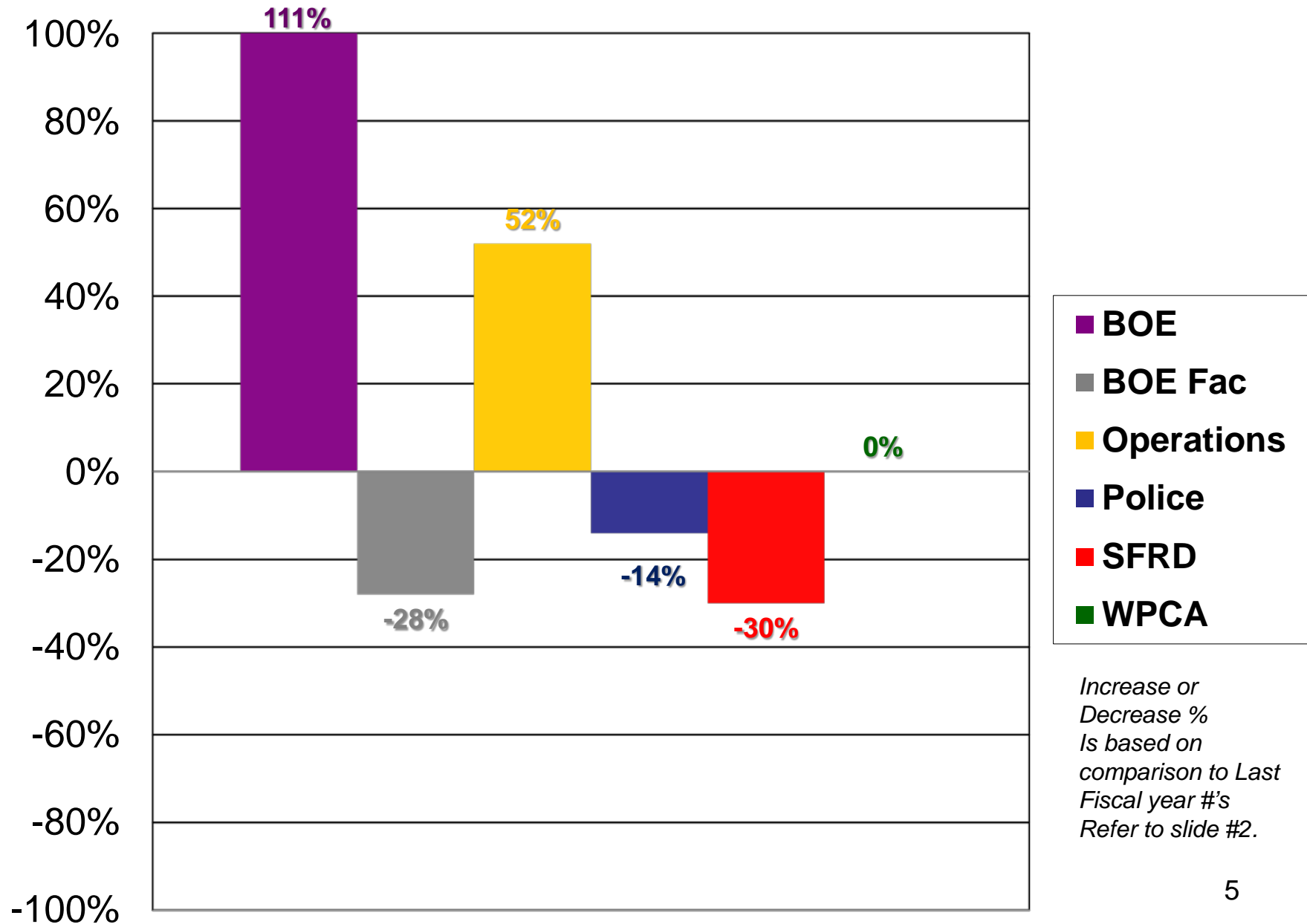
# 3 Year *Fiscal* Comparison by Dept.



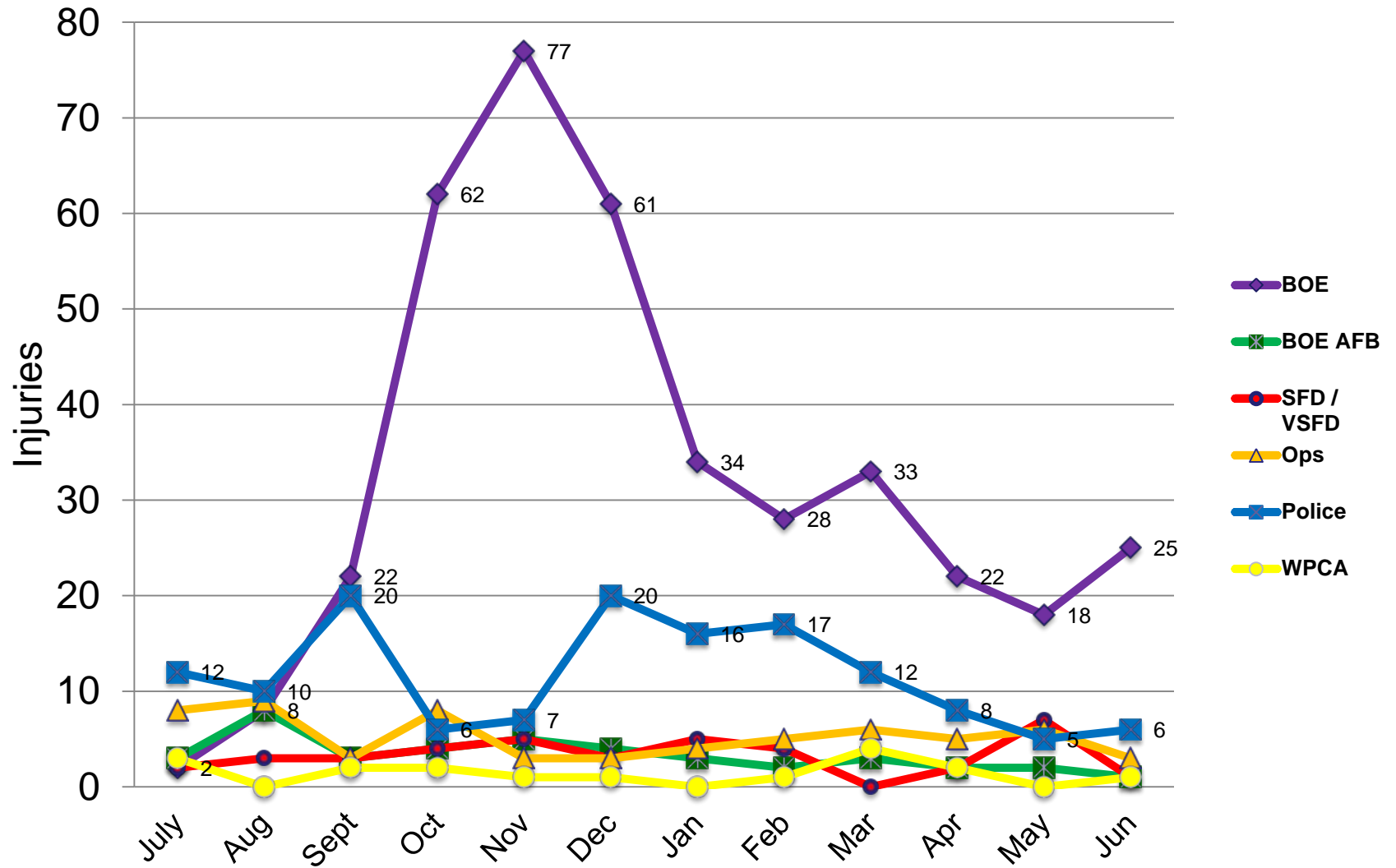
## 3 Year Comparison Total Claims *Fiscal*



# Fiscal Claim performance 17-18 vs. 18-19

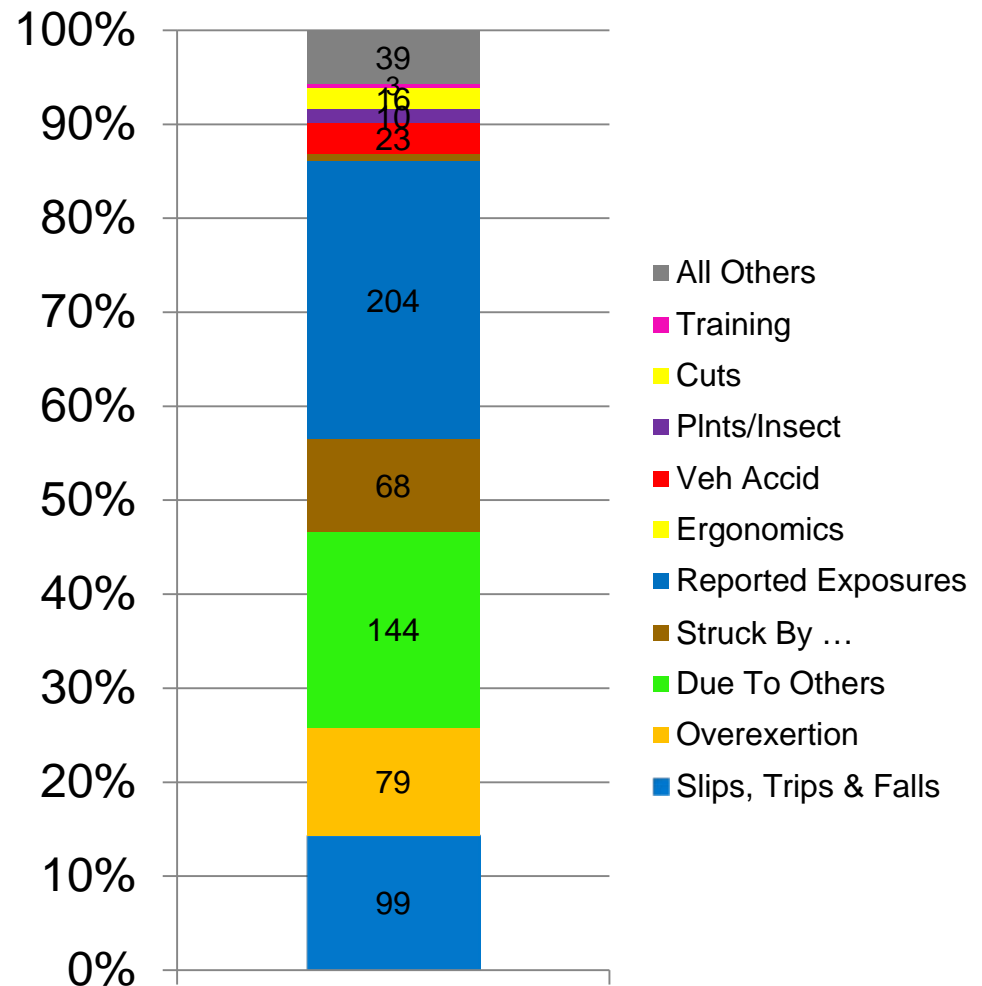

# Top 4 Leading Causes of Claims FY 2018/19

Type	# of Incidents	% of Total
<b>›Reported Exposures</b> (BOE, Teacher (168) Para (26) and custodian (10) Reported Exposures due to reported mold.)	204	30%
<b>›Due To Others</b> (Caused by others, combative subject, violence, Police/BOE)	144	21%
<b>›Slip, Trip, &amp; Falls</b> (All ice, wet, objects, stairs, ladders, etc.)	99	14%
<b>›Overexertion</b> (all lifting, bending/twisting, push/pull, strain)	68	10%



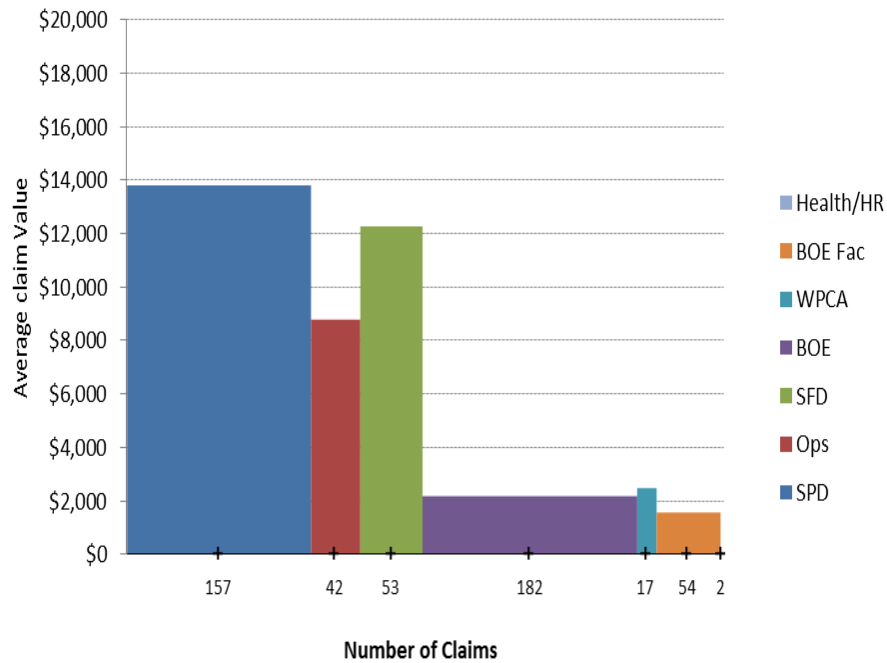
# •Fiscal 2 Year Cost Comparison



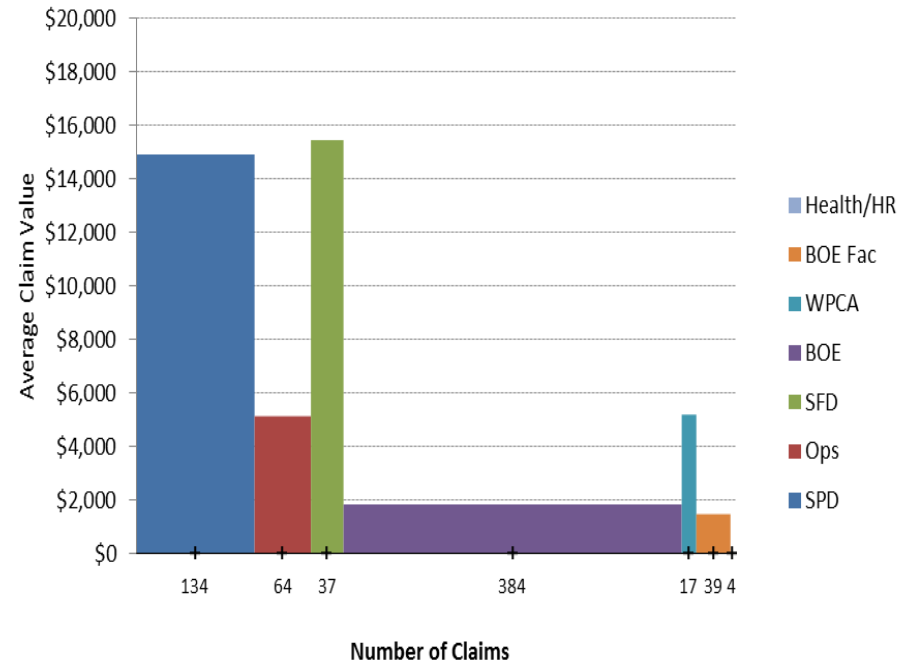


## Average Claim severity Fiscal comparison last two years

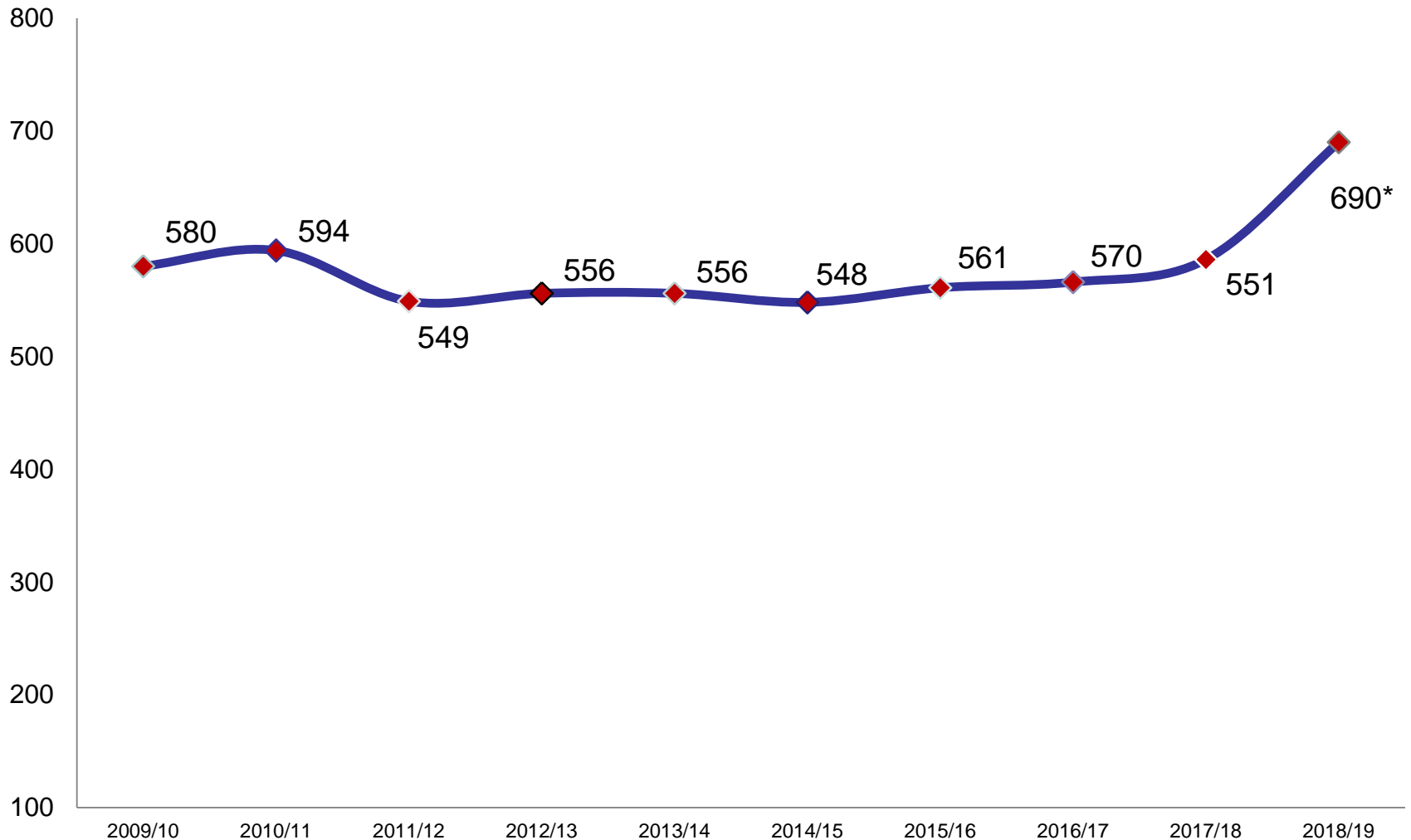
Claims FY17/18



Claims FY 18/19

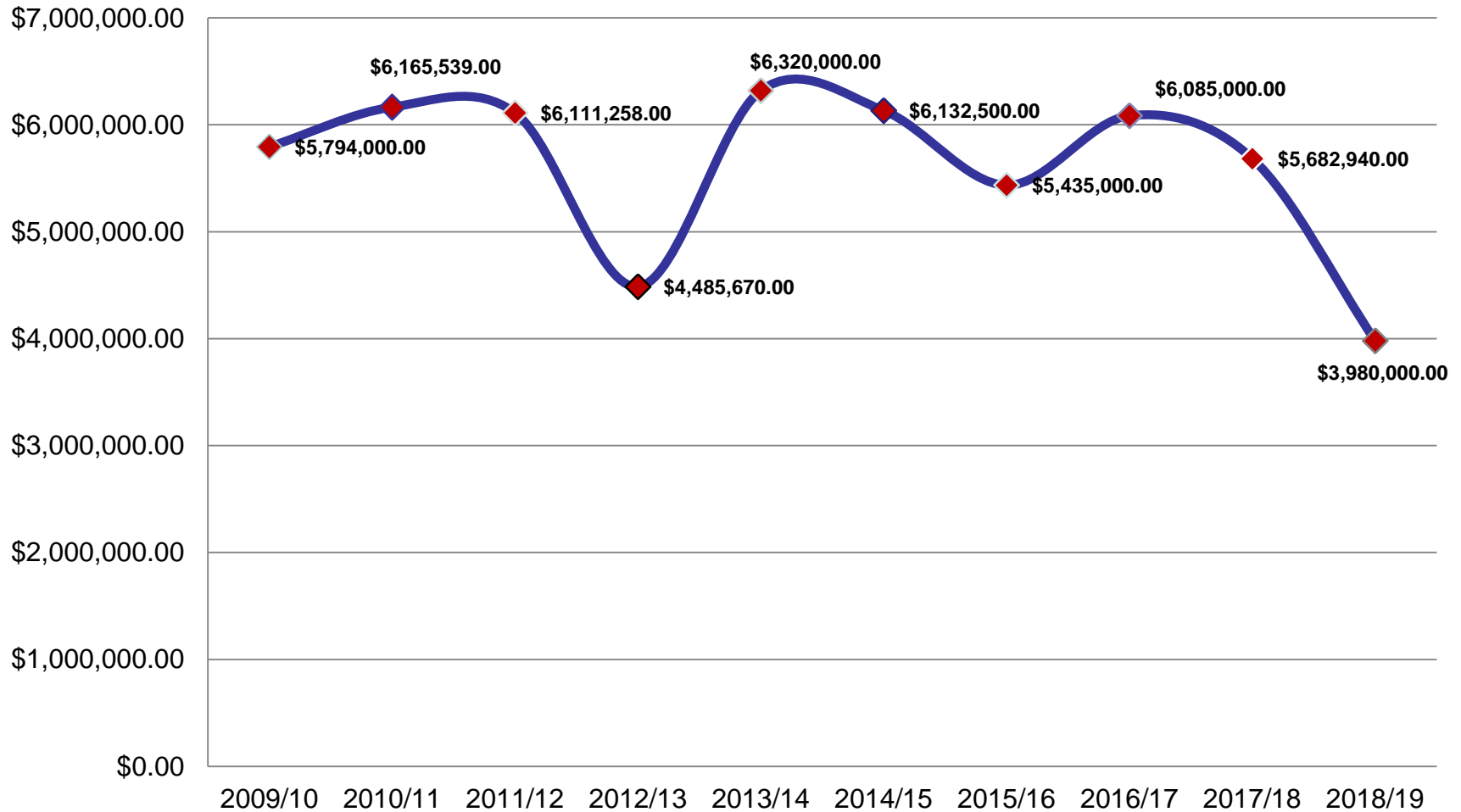


# 10 yr. Claim Comparison



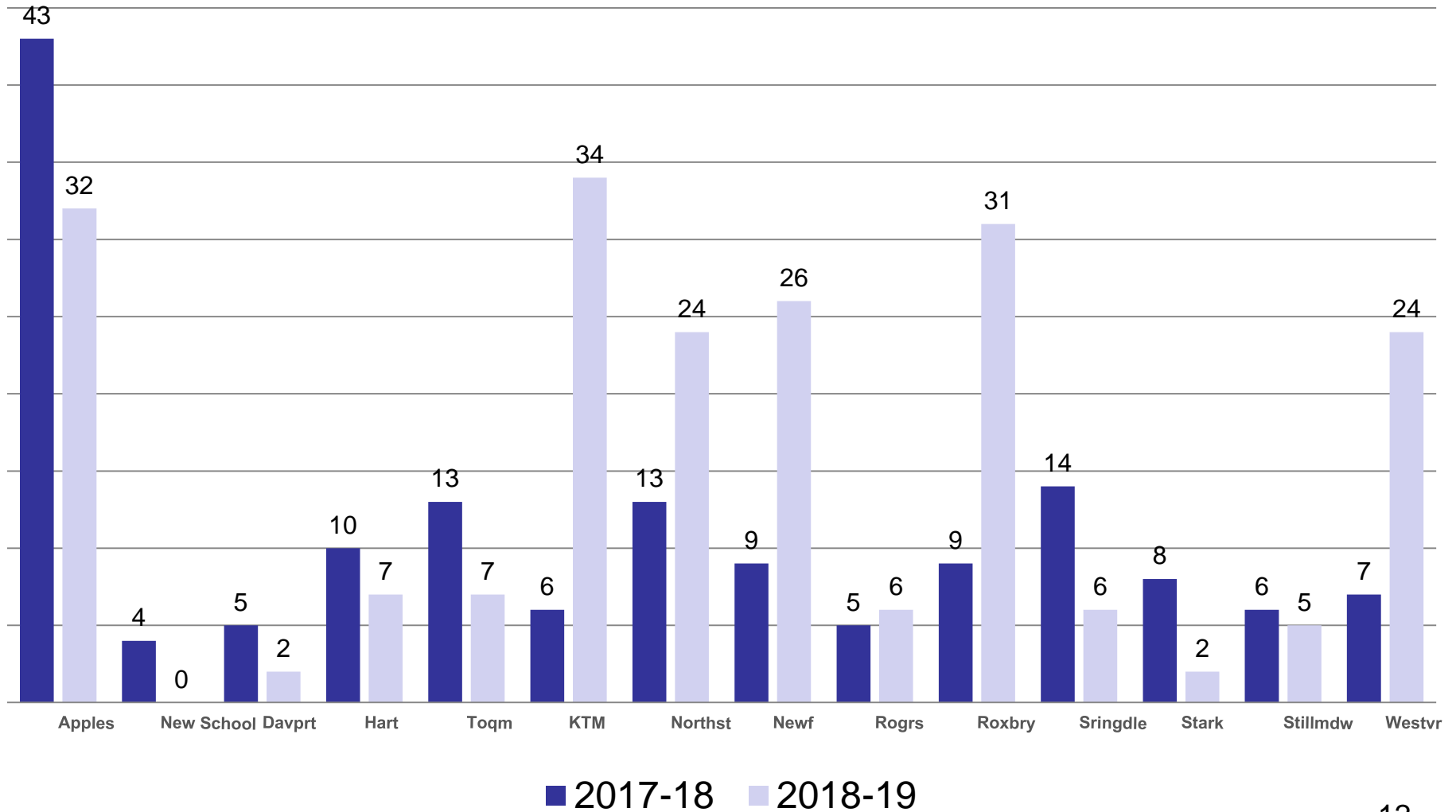
\* Total of 690 claims for fiscal 18/19 is representative of the reported mold exposure claims as well. If the 204 Mold exposure claims were omitted, then the total injuries for City of Stamford employees would total 486, the first time ever under 500 worker comp injuries.

# 10 yr. Dollar Comparison

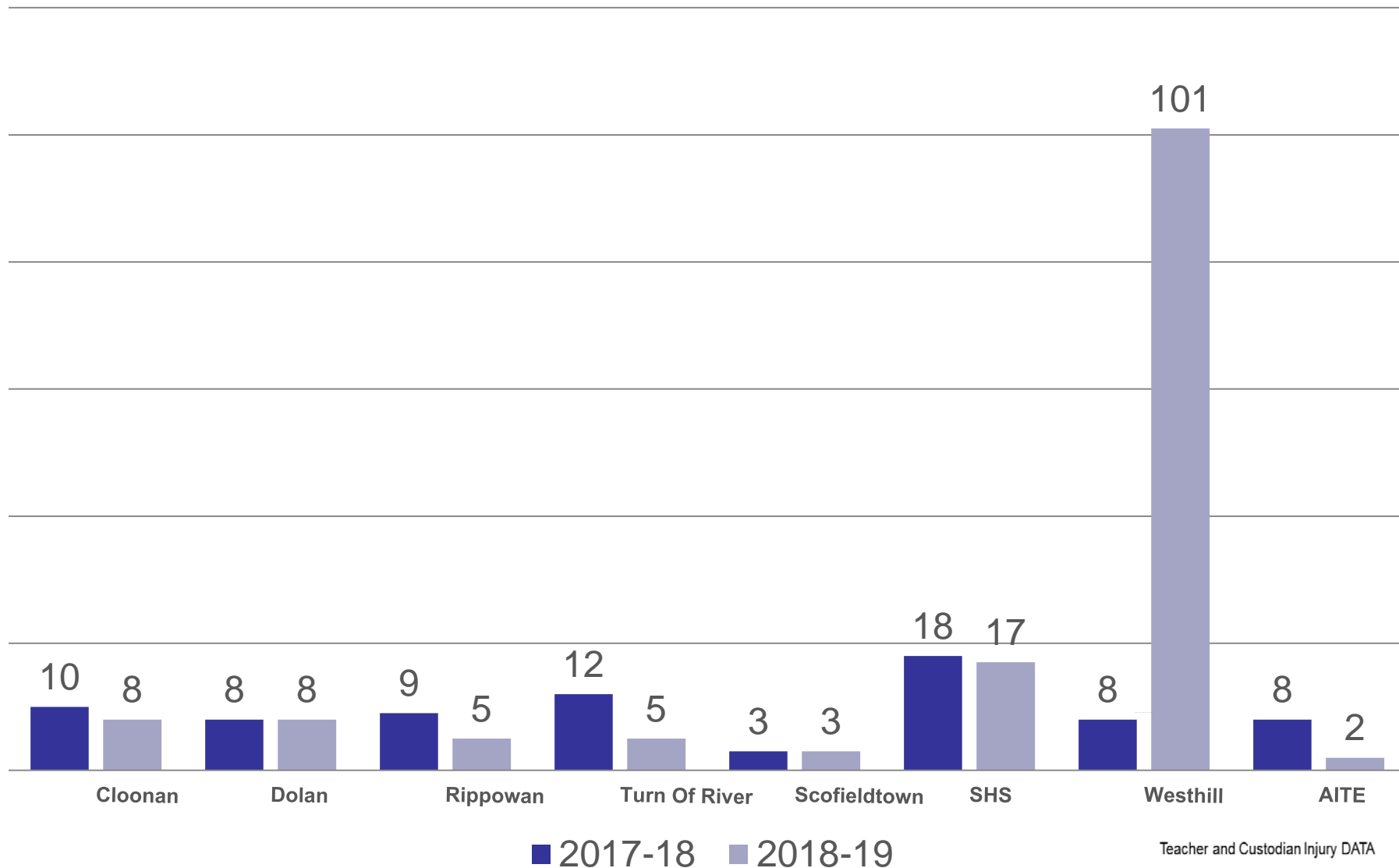


\* 18/19 is recent without total cost accumulation accrued. There are always fluctuations post fiscal year as many injury treatments continue on to the next fiscal period.

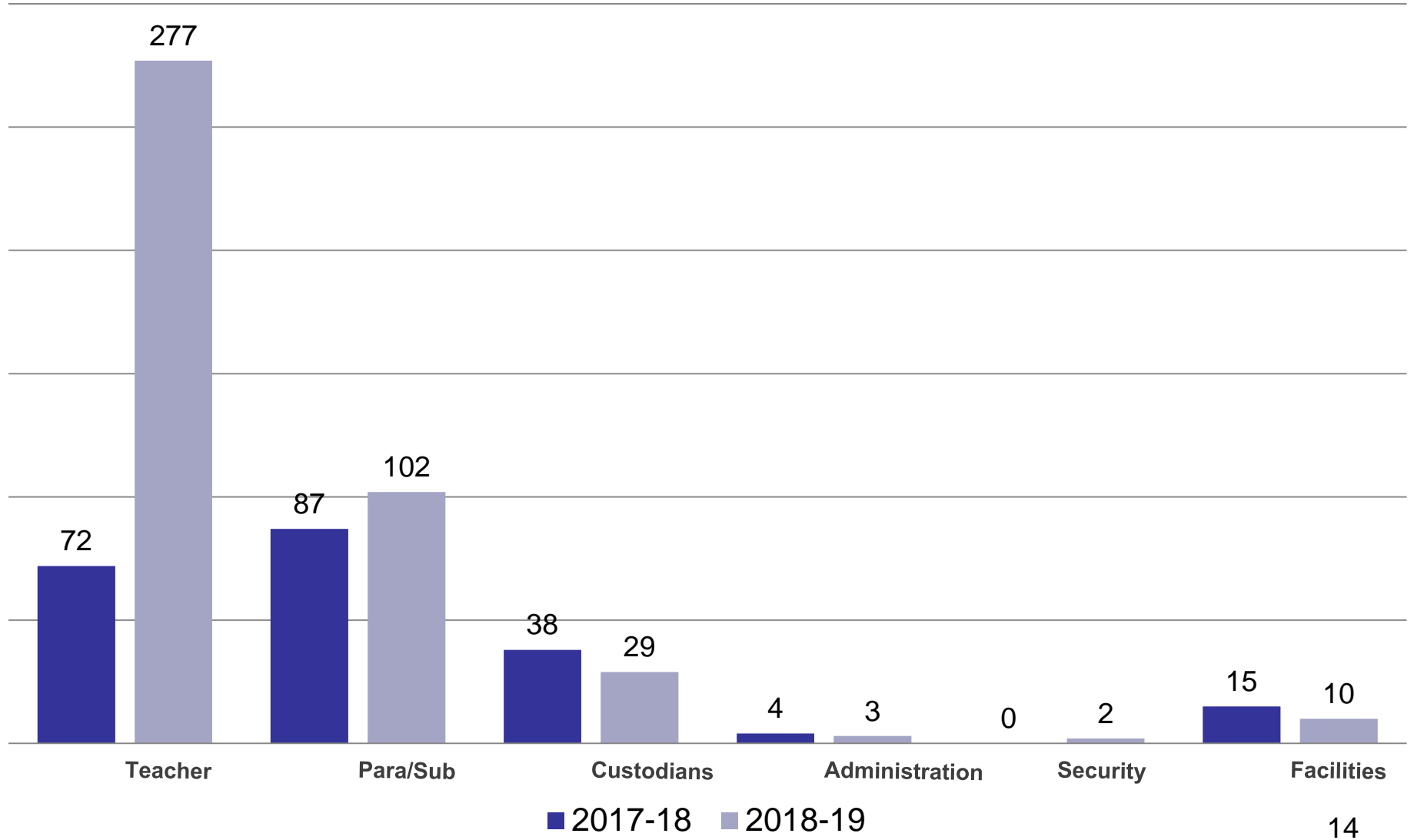
# BOE *Elementary* Schools YTD Incident Comparison



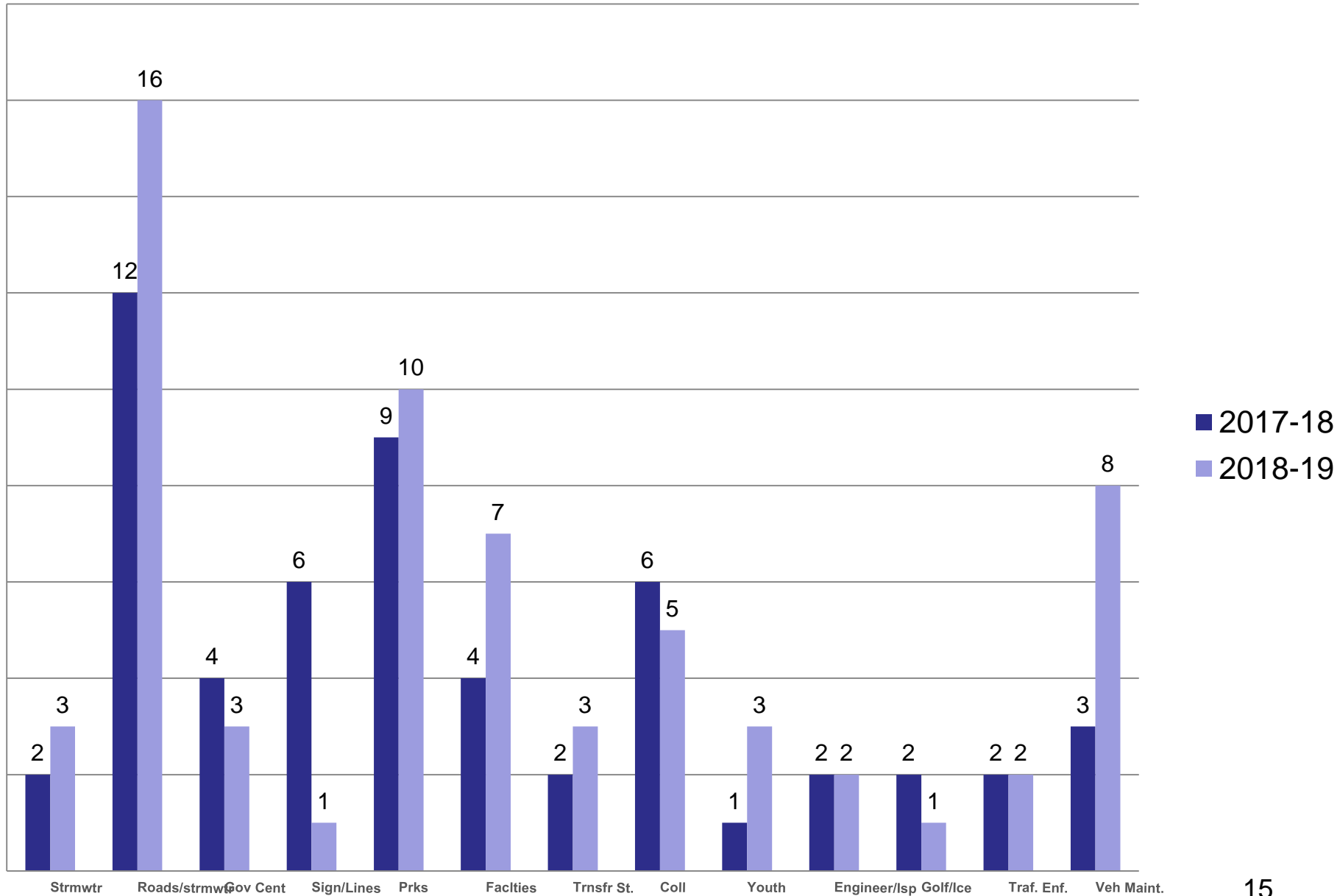
## BOE Middle & High Schools YTD Incident Comparison

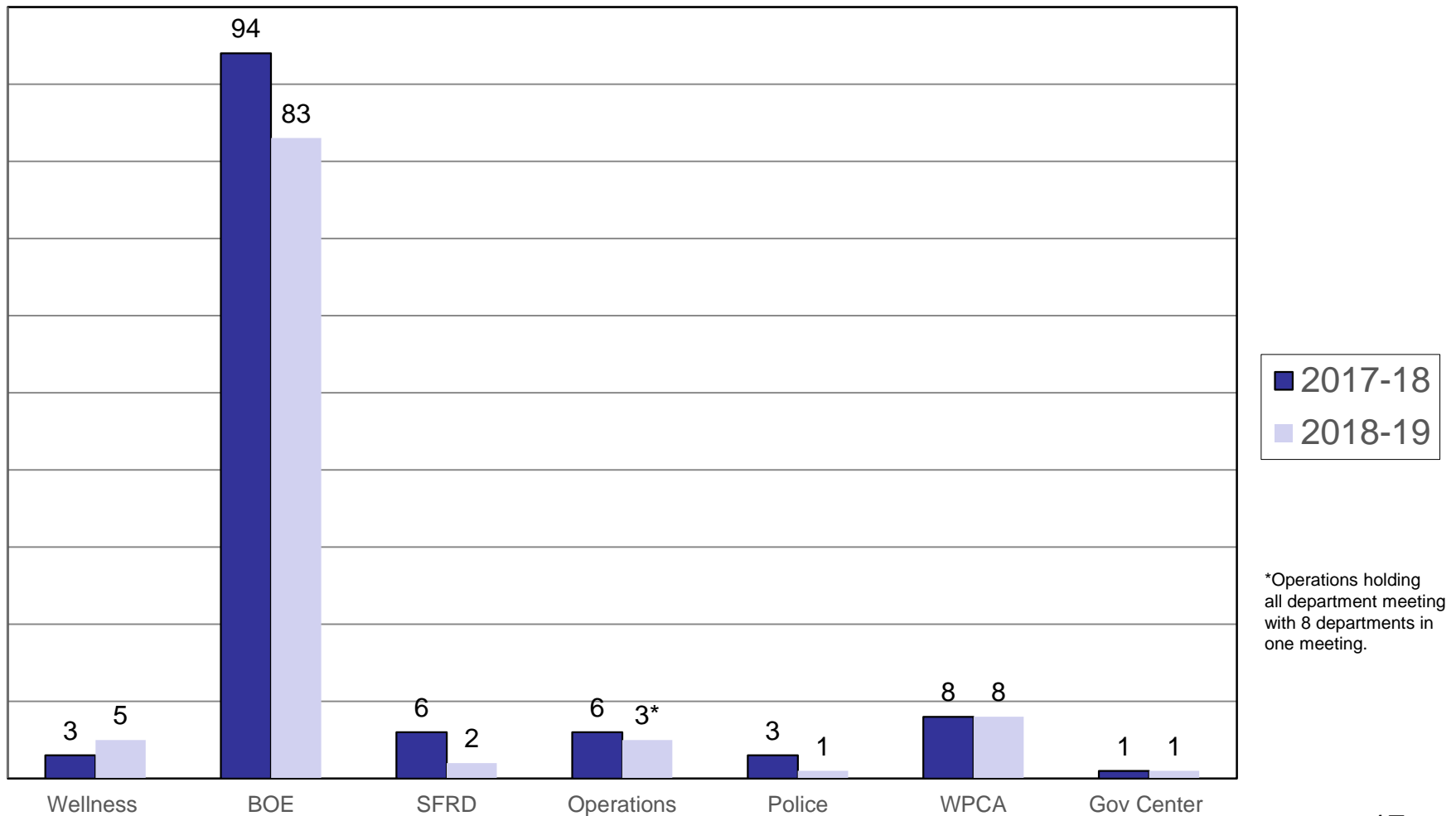

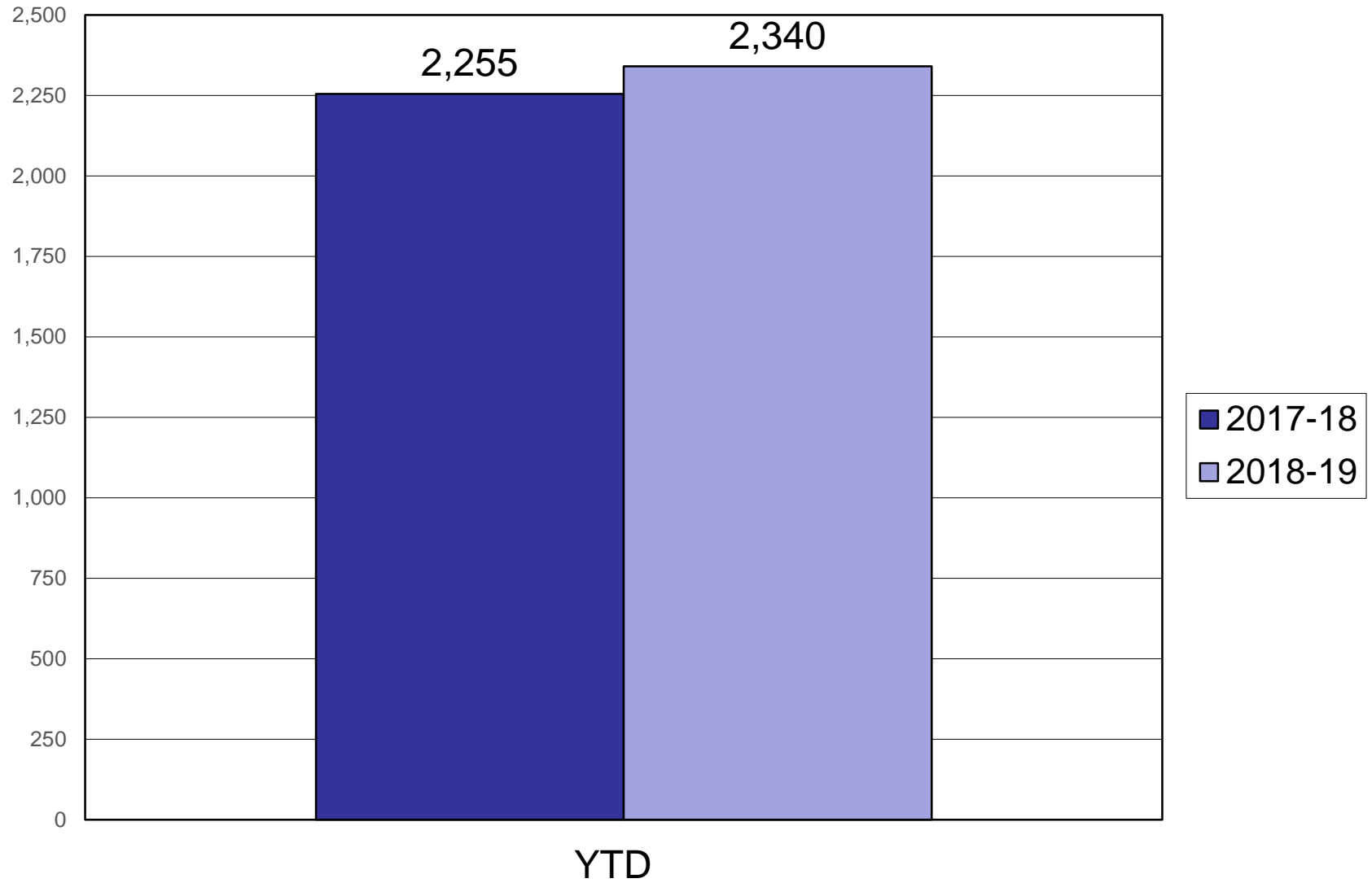
