

BOE Reported Mold Exposures


The Board of Education has had a number of employee injury reports filled out due to the presence of reported mold exposures in some our schools.

We have received a total of 204 reported exposures in fiscal 2018/2019, representing 30% of all claims within the city and 53% of the teachers / para claims. The exposures will be reflected in various slides in the following report.


3 Year Fiscal Comparison by Dept.




3 Year Comparison Total Claims Fiscal



Fiscal Claim performance 17-18 vs. 18-19




Fiscal year analysis claims by month




Top 4 Leading Causes of Claims FY 2018/19



▶Due To Others (Caused by others, combative subject, violence, Police/BOE)	144	21%
<u>>Slip, Trip, & Falls</u> (All ice, wet, objects, stairs, ladders, etc.)	99	14%
<u>>Overexertion</u> (all lifting, bending/twisting, push/pull, strain)	68	10%




Fiscal 2 Year Cost Comparison




Average Claim severity Fiscal comparison last two years






10 yr. Claim Comparison





10 yr. Dollar Comparison




^{* 18/19} is recent without total cost accumulation accrued. There are always fluctuations post fiscal year as many injury treatments continue on to the next fiscal period.


BOE *Elementary* Schools YTD Incident Comparison




BOE Middle & High Schools YTD Incident Comparison



BOE Other YTD Incident Comparison




Operations YTD Incident Comparison
