Subject: Request to dispose of property - photograph of former Superintendent of Schools

Dear Erik:

For many years, the wall outside the office of the Superintendent of Schools displayed the photographs of Stamford's former Superintendents. The display was removed a few years ago and the photos were stored.

Mr. Joe Franchina, the great-grandson of a former Superintendent of Schools Joseph Franchina, has asked the original portrait of his grandfather be returned to the Franchina family. Mr. Franchina hopes to present it to his father where it will have pride of place in his home. I have attached a copy of Mr. Franchina's heartfelt request for your review.

Pursuant to City Ordinance 23.18-13.3(b), if the Purchasing Agent determines "surplus or unusable supplies, materials or equipment materials have no market value," then the Purchasing Agent may "throw out or dispose of same" upon written approval of the Mayor to do so.

It is my suggestion that from the City's perspective the photograph holds no market value, although it clearly holds great sentimental value for the Franchina Family. Its value to the City is purely historical. This historic interest may be preserved by retaining a printed/scanned copy of the

photograph in the archive.

The photograph at issue is a sepia toned photograph done by Loring Studio. It is in a wooden frame with a small engraved plaque on the front "Joseph J. Franchina 1960-1965". The original photograph size is 20×24 with no mat within the frame. The Board of Education scanned the photograph and made a 16×20 matte copy. A scan of the photograph is attached for your review.

I am writing to ask you to please assess this piece of property and determine whether or not the original photograph holds any market value for the City. If there is no market value, and you are amenable to disposing of this property by way of gift to the Franchina Family, I will seek the Mayor's permission to do so. If granted, I will be happy to take care of the arrangements for the family and the photograph to be reunited.

Hi Amy,


