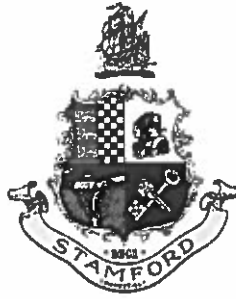

**RESOLUTION NO. 2674
ACCEPTING WEST ROCK TRAIL, WEST KNOBLOCH LANE AND KNOBLOCH LANE AS CITY
STREETS**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2551 was enacted on January 4, 2000, initiating the process of the acceptance streets referred to as West Rock Trail, West Knobloch Lane and Knobloch Lane as City Streets under Charter Division 2, Estimates and Capital Projects, Section C8-20-1 to C8-20-11 and Division 6, Section C8-60-1 to Section C8-60-17; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department has submitted written confirmation that the Petitioner has complied with all requirements.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 26TH BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT

The highways known as West Rock Trail, West Knobloch Lane and Knobloch Lane are in conformance with the specifications set forth in Section 214.37 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Stamford; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the highways known as West Rock Trail, West Knobloch Lane and Knobloch Lane are accepted as City Streets.

This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
