

Whereas, Richard and Vivienne Silver, in recognition of Jacob and Shirley Silver's commitment to the City of Stamford, have made a sizeable donation to the rebuilding of the educational building at the Bartlett Arboretum & Gardens and have requested that it be renamed the Silver Educational Center in honor of Jacob and Shirley Silver.
