RESOLUTION NO. 1484

PARK REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 15-1 of the Stamford Municipal Code of Ordinances, the Park Commission of the City of Stamford has promulgated rules and regulations for the health, welfare and safety of the community; and

WHEREAS, said rules and regulations are necessary for the proper safety, maintenance, security, and efficient operation of said Parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following rules and regulations shall be adopted and apply to all Park Property in the City of Stamford.

SECTION I

NO PERSON SHALL:

- 1) Intentionally or wantonly damage Park lawns, trees, shrubs, flowers or any other Park area, building or equipment.
- 2) Peddle or sell goods, merchandise or food without a Park Permit.
- 3) Light fires except in grills or fireplaces placed by the Department of Parks or in portable grills in locations designated as picnic areas. No fires of any kind shall be kindled on beaches.
- 4) Violate any established curfew.
- 5) Dump brush, tree clippings or household debris in Parks.

Any person who commits, takes part in, or assists in any violation of this Section shall be fined seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) for each offense. Each violation shall be a separate and distinct offense and in the case of a continuing violation, each day's continuance thereof shall be deemed to be a separate and distinct offense.

SECTION II

NO PERSON SHALL:

- 1) Serve, consume or transport any beverage or food in a glass container on Park Property.
- 2) Serve or consume intoxicating or alcoholic beverages on Park Property except beer in cans or keg beer in cups.
- 3) Bring firearms or other lethal weapons into a Park.
- 4) Hold mass meetings or public assemblies on Park Property except with a City Permit.

Any person who commits, takes part in, or assists in any violation of this Section shall be fined fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each offense. Each violation shall be a separate and distinct offense and in the case of a continuing violation, each day's continuance thereof shall be deemed to be a separate and distinct offense.

SECTION III

NO PERSON SHALL:

- 1) Discard paper, household trash or rubbish in Park containers except for materials left over from picnics and other lawful gatherings in a Park.
- 2) Play organized games in Parks except in areas designated for such activities. A Park Permit must be obtained when required for specified areas.
- 3) Drive, chip or otherwise play golf in any Park.
- 4) Repair vehicles in a Park.
- 5) Park or drive a vehicle on Park Property except in designated area.
- 6) Disturb any birds or other wildlife on Park Property.
- 7) Leave a boat on Park Property without permission. Any boat left without permission will be impounded by the Department of Parks and stored at owner's expense of \$1.00 per day.
- 8) Walk or allow a dog to roam on a beach or tether said animal to a tree or other object within the beach area.
- 9) Disobey posted Park signs and warnings.

PARK REGULATIONS

Any person who commits, takes part in, or assists in any violation of this Section shall be fined twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each offense. Each violation shall be a separate and distinct offense and in the case of a continuing violation, each day's continuance thereof shall be deemed to be a separate and distinct offense.

Violation of any of the regulations in these Sections shall be considered an infraction and the appropriate fine shall be levied.

These rules and regulations shall supersede all Park rules and regulations previously established.

This resolution shall take effect upon its enactment.


