NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT:

Article X, Chapter 6 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE X. AQUIFER PROTECTION AGENCY

Sec. 6-51. Designation; membership.

A. In accordance with the provisions of Sections 22a-354 et seq. of the Connecticut General Statutes, the [Environmental Protection Board (hereinafter "EPB")] **Zoning Board** is hereby designated as the Aquifer Protection Agency (hereinafter "APA") of the City of Stamford. The staff of the [EPB] **Zoning Board** shall serve as the staff of the APA.

B. Members of the [EPB] **Zoning Board** shall serve coexisting terms on the APA. The membership requirements of the APA shall be the same as those of the [EPB] **Zoning Board**, including but not limited to the number of members, conditions, terms and political affiliation. When a member of the [EPB] **Zoning Board** leaves or is removed from office, his/her term on the APA shall simultaneously end.

C. At least one member of the APA or staff of the APA shall be a person who has completed the course in technical training formulated by the Commissioner of Environmental Protection of the State of Connecticut, pursuant to Section 22a-354v of the Connecticut General Statutes.
