**RESOLUTION NO.  
CONCERNING A FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION  
OF THE ENTERPRISE ZONE ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Representatives adopted “Ordinance Number 724 Supplemental Concerning the Creation of an Enterprise Zone,” on February 1, 1994; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 7 of Ordinance No. 724 provides that “this ordinance shall expire at 12:00 midnight, on December 31, 2003, unless otherwise extended by a resolution of the Board of Representatives;” and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 724 has been codified in the City of Stamford Code of Ordinances as Chapter 117; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 10, 2003 Resolution No. 2839 extended Chapter 117 of the Stamford Code of Ordinances for five additional years through December 21, 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Representatives has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Stamford for Chapter 117 of the Code of Ordinances to remain in effect for the next five years.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford, does hereby approve of the extension of Chapter 117 of the Code of Ordinances until 12:00 midnight, December 31, 2013; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Chapter 117 of the Code of Ordinances shall expire at 12:00 midnight, on December 31, 2013, unless otherwise extended by a resolution of the Board of Representatives.

This resolution will take effect upon enactment.
