RESOLUTION NO. 3257
CONCERNING A FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION OF THE
ENTERPRISE ZONE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS; the Board of Representatives adopted "Ordinance Number 724 Supplemental Concerning the Creation of an Enterprise Zone," on February 1, 1994; and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of Ordinance No. 724 provides that "this ordinance shall expire at 1200 midnight, on December 31, 2003, unless otherwise extended by a resolution of the Board of Representatives;" and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 724 has been codified in the City of Stamford Code of Ordinances as Chapter 117; and

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2003 Resolution No. 2839 extended Chapter 117 of the Stamford Code of Ordinances for five additional years through December 21, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Stamford for Chapter 117 of the Code of Ordinances to remain in effect for the next five years.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford, does hereby approve of the extension of Chapter 117 of the Code of Ordinances until 12:00 midnight, December 31, 2013; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Chapter 117 of the Code of Ordinances shall expire at 12:00 midnight on December 31, 2013, unless otherwise extended by a resolution of the Board of Representatives.

This resolution will take effect upon enactment.
