RESOLUTION NO. 4170 RESOLUTION RELATED TO THE APPLICATION FOR HVAC INDOOR AIR QUALITY SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION GRANT FOR STAMFORD HIGH SCHOOL HVAC REPLACEMENT AND UPGRADE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Finance and the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford, Connecticut (the "City") previously approved the appropriation and financing of planning, design, engineering, construction, procurement for the Boiler Plant upgrades and Belimo Valve replacement for Stamford High School, 55 Strawberry Hill Avenue, Stamford, CT, including but not limited to, related permitting, environmental and site work for (the "Stamford High School HVAC Replacement and Upgrade Project"), Project No. CPBM31; and

WHEREAS, the Stamford High School HVAC Replacement and Upgrade Project has been completed and was financed with funds on hand of the City or with bond proceeds in the amount of \$2,458,584.78; and

WHEREAS, with respect to the Stamford High School HVAC Replacement and Upgrade Project, the City desires to submit a grant application with the State of Connecticut Office of School Construction and Grants Review under the HVAC Indoor Air Quality Reimbursement Program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CITY OF STAMFORD:

Section 1. The Board of Representatives hereby authorizes the Stamford Board of Education to take any and all necessary actions to apply to the Commissioner of Administrative Services and to accept or reject a grant for the HVAC IAQ Grant for the Stamford High School HVAC Replacement and Upgrade Project.

Section 2. With respect to the HVAC IAQ Grant for the Stamford High School HVAC Replacement and Upgrade Project, the School Building Committee members (A) submitted by the Mayor shall consist of (i) a Licensed Architect who is a resident of the City of Stamford, (ii) the City Building Inspector, (iii) the City Engineer, and (iv) a resident of the City of Stamford, and (B) which shall be subject to Board of Representatives approval and shall serve until a replacement shall have been appointed and approved by the Board of Representatives shall consist of (i) the President of the Board of Education (or designee), (ii) the Chairman of the Planning Board (or designee),

(iii) the Chairman of the Board of Finance (or designee), and (iv) the President of the Board of Representatives (or designee); and any additional members as may be required by the State of Connecticut.

Section 3. To affirm authorization of the preparation of schematic drawings and outline specifications, and a project scope and budget for the HVAC IAQ Grant for the Stamford High School HVAC Replacement and Upgrade Project.

This resolution was approved by Unanimous Voice Vote at a Special Meeting of the 31st Board of Representatives held on November 28, 2022.
