RESOLUTION NO. 3670 CREATING A SPECIAL COMMITTEE TO REVIEW THE RESOMMENDATIONS FROM THE BOARD OF FINANCE FOR COST SAVINGS AND REVENUE ENHANCEMENT

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2014, the Board of Finance sent a letter to the Board of Representatives recommending various actions for costs savings and revenue enhancement within the City of Stamford; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Representatives has determined that it is in the best interests of the City for there to be a special committee to review and evaluate these recommendations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the 29th Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford that the President of the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford appoint a special committee to review and evaluate the recommendations contained in the May 28, 2014 letter from the Board of Finance; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee consist of not less than five (5) members appointed by the President with input from the Majority and Minority Leaders; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such special committee shall meet on a monthly basis at the discretion of the chair of the committee; and

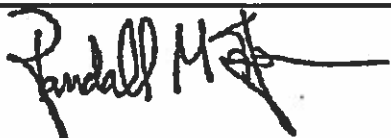
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such special committee shall review and evaluate the recommendations contained in the May 28, 2014 letter from the Board of Finance and, if deemed advisable, develop additional recommendations for cost savings and revenue enhancement within the City of Stamford; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such special committee shall report back to the Board of Representatives with recommendations for any legislation that may be necessary for cost savings and revenue enhancement within the City of Stamford; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the report of such special committee shall be placed after the reports of the Standing Committees on the agenda of the monthly Board of Representatives meeting.

This resolution will take effect upon enactment.
