## RESOLUTION NO. 3897 TO ACCEPT A \$553,795 CDBG-DR GRANT FROM THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING FOR GENERATOR UPGRADES AND EQUIPMENT COOLING

WHEREAS, federal monies are available under the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program, administered by the State of Connecticut, Department of Housing pursuant to Public Law 93-3 83, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Connecticut has received a special allocation of *CDBG-DR* funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, in response to Superstorm Sandy, authorized under the federal Disaster Relief Appropriations Act of 2013; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 127c, and Part VI of Chapter 130 of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Commissioner of Housing is authorized to disburse such federal monies to local municipalities; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Connecticut has made these funds available to municipalities and others through a Notice of Funds Availability issued by its *Department of Housing*; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stamford applied for and was awarded a CDBG-DR Grant in the amount of \$303,795 to upgrade the generators serving the 911/Emergency Operations Center at the Stamford Government Center and has subsequently been awarded an additional \$250,000 for an equipment cooling system for the EOC, for a total grant amount of \$553,795; and

**WHEREAS**, the upgrades will ensure continuity of operations of critical infrastructure in the City of Stamford;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 30<sup>th</sup> BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE CITY OF STAMFORD:

1. That it is cognizant of an award by the State of Connecticut, acting by and through its **Department of Housing**, of a CDBG-DR Planning Grant **in an amount not to exceed** \$553,795; and

2. That it hereby authorizes, directs and empowers *David R. Martin, Mayor of the City of Stamford*, to execute whatever documents may be required by the Commissioner of the *Department of Housing*, to obtain this award, to provide any required additional information, to execute an Assistance Agreement with the State of Connecticut for State Financial assistance, and to execute any such other contracts, amendments, rescissions, and revisions thereto, and to act as the authorized representative of the City of Stamford.
