- Purpose Public Bidding
- Low Bid/Offer Acceptance
- Coops/State Bidding

{Revised for Ordinance Number 865 Effective Date = February 27, 1999}

Purchasing Ordinance

Procurement of Goods and General Services

- Under \$3,000 -- No quotes
- 3 Quotes for \$3,000 \$7,500
- Competitive Bids if Greater Than \$7,500

Purchasing Ordinance (continue)

Procurement of Special or Professional Services

- Under \$10,000 -- No Quotes
- **3** Written Quotes \$10,000 \$25,000
- Competitive Proposals if Greater Than \$25,000

Procurement of All Services

\$25,000 or More Requires a Contract

Purchasing Ordinance (continue)

Bid Waiver Process

- For Either Critical Emergencies or Other Reasons Specified in the Purchase Ordinance 23-18.3
- Approval by Purchasing Agent, Director of Administration, and Mayor
- If Over \$50,000 BOF Approval Required

Purchasing Ordinance (continue)

Contracts

- \$25,000 Purchase Order May Be Used For Services Under
- Contract Required For Services Over \$25,000
- \$100,000 or More Approval By Mayor, BOF, and **BOR Required**

Contract Compliance

- Section 23-18.8 of Purchasing Ordinance
- **Quarterly Reports Provided**
- Contracts awarded by the competitive bidding process
- Contracts awarded by the competitive proposal process
- Waivers of the competitive bidding or proposal process
- Contracts, which have been extended
- Contracts obtained through state bids/GSA contracts/cooperatives

Proposed Changes to Purchasing Ordinance

Procurement of Goods and General Services

- Under \$3,000 -- No quotes
- 3 Quotes for \$3,000 <u>- \$7,500</u> to \$3,000 \$10,000
- Competitive Bids if Greater Than \$7,500 to \$10,000

Proposed Changes to Purchasing Ordinance (continue)

Procurement of Special or Professional Services

- Under \$10,000 -- No Quotes
- 3 Written Quotes \$10,000 \$25,000
- Competitive Proposals if Greater Than \$25,000

Procurement of All Services

= \$25,000 to \$50,000 or More Requires a Contract

Proposed Changes to Purchasing Ordinance (continue)

Bid Waiver Process

- For Either Critical Emergencies or Other Reasons Specified in the Purchase Ordinance 23-18.3
- Approval by Purchasing Agent, Director of Administration, and Mayor
- If Over \$50,000 \$100,000 BOF Approval <u>Required</u>
