RESOLUTION NO. 4022 CORRECTING A SCRIVENER'S ERROR IN SECTION 6-19 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION BOARD

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 286 Supplemental, concerning Establishment of an Environmental Protection Board was approved for final adoption by the 13th Board of Representatives on June 3, 1974; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 286 Supplemental is codified at Chapter 6, Article V of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, a scrivener's error was recently discovered in subsection 6-19.B of the ordinance; and

WHEREAS; it is necessary to correct said ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 30TH BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES THAT:

A scrivener's error in Section 6-19 of the Code of Ordinances, concerning the Environmental Protection Board, shall be corrected and said section shall henceforth read as follows.

Sec. 6-19. - Title; purpose.

- A. This Article shall be known as the "Environmental Protection Ordinance" of the City of Stamford.
- B. The following provisions of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Act, Public Act 155, 1972, as amended by Public Act 571, 1973, Section 22a-36 et seq. of the Connecticut General Statutes for the protection, regulation and acquisition of inland wetlands and watercourses within the city; Section 25-84 et seq. of the Connecticut General Statutes for the adoption of a Municipal Flood and Erosion Control Board; and Section 7-131(a) et seq. of the Connecticut General Statutes to establish a local Conservation Commission shall apply to the City of Stamford.
