D. Voting

6. In event of a declaration of a state of emergency by the Governor of State of Connecticut or the Mayor of the City of Stamford or other similar circumstance in which the Board of Representatives is unable to meet in person and conducts a Regular or Special Meeting either by telephone or videoconference, members of the Board of Representatives must identify themselves as being present at said Board meeting prior to voting, either during roll call or subsequent thereto. Members shall notify the Clerk of the Board when joining or leaving the meeting, who shall announce that such member has joined or left the meeting. Members who fail to notify the clerk will not be considered present. The meeting shall be conducted in such a manner so that all participating members can hear each other vote, or if by video conference see and hear each other. No member shall be permitted to vote by email, text or telephone call to another member or to the Clerk of the Board.
