RESOLUTION NO. 3616 ACCEPTING A GIFT FROM THE WHERE ANGELS PLAY FOUNDATION TOWARD A PLAYGROUND

WHEREAS, Sec. C2-10-2(7) of the Charter provides that the Board of Representatives shall have the power to receive gifts of money or property in excess of a value to be determined by the Board from time to time; and


WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 2-10-2(7) of the Charter, the Mayor or the Mayor's designee is hereby authorized to accept gifts of money or property with an appraised or estimated value of \$5,000 or less on behalf of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Where Angels Play Foundation wishes to donate \$80,000 to \$120,000 to the City of Stamford toward the building of a playground in memory of Jesse Lewis, a victim of the shooting at Sandy Hook Elementary School.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 29th BOARD OF REPRESENTATIVES that the following gift is accepted by the City of Stamford.

\$80,000 to \$120,000 from the Where Angels Play Foundation.
