## **RESOLUTION NO. 4034 CREATING A SPECIAL COMMITTEE TO REVIEW CHAPTER 19 OF THE CITY OF STAMFORD CODE OF ORDINANCES**

**WHEREAS**, adherence to the highest standards of ethical conduct by all elected and appointed officials is essential to establishing a trusted and effective municipal government; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the City that its ethics ordinance be thoroughly reviewed from time to time to ensure that it adheres to the values of the City and to determine whether improvements are necessary to align with state and national best practices.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the 30th Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford that the President of the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford appoint a special committee to review Chapter 19 of the Code of Ordinances to recommend possible improvements and updates in accordance with the values of the City of Stamford and best practices for such ordinances; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the committee consist of not less than seven (7) members; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that such special committee shall meet at the discretion of the chair of the committee; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that such special committee shall report back to the Board of Representatives with recommendations of possible improvements to Chapter 19. The recommendations may include but are not limited to the following:

1. Proposed legislation
2. Initiatives within the Board of Representatives' office, its members, and/or Leadership
3. Initiatives by city departments

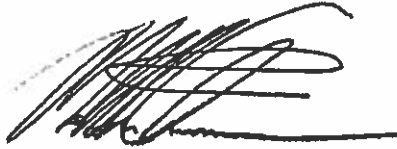

This resolution will take effect upon enactment.

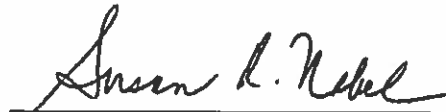
