**WHEREAS**, Moira Lyons served as a member of the Connecticut House of Representatives as a representative for the 146<sup>th</sup> District from 1980 to 2004, serving as Chair of several committees, Majority Leader and Assistant Speaker, and was the first woman to be elected Speaker of the House on January 6, 1999; and

**WHEREAS**, Moira Lyons was the Connecticut representative to the National State Legislative Transportation Board; and

**WHEREAS**, Moira Lyons served on several Boards and Commissions in the City of Stamford including the Stamford Committee on Training and Employment and the Commission on Youth Alcohol and Drug Abuse; and

**WHEREAS**, Moira Lyons now serves on the Stamford Police Commission and is the Community Development Director at Norwalk Community College
