

**SENSE OF THE BOARD RESOLUTION
RECOGNIZING PHIL GIORDANO'S MANY YEARS OF SERVICE
TO THE CITY OF STAMFORD, INCLUDING 26 YEARS ON THE BOARD OF
REPRESENTATIVES**

WHEREAS, Philip J. Giordano was born in Stamford on August 22, 1927 and has been a lifelong Stamford resident, attending Stamford schools, including the Center, Hart, and Burdick Schools, Stamford High School and the J.M. Wright Technical High School; and

WHEREAS, Philip J. Giordano served in the U.S. Army 2nd Division, 15th Field Artillery, Headquarters Battery from 1946 through 1947 and worked for the Stamford Board of Education as a custodian until his retirement as Head Custodian; and

WHEREAS, Philip J. Giordano joined the Board of Representatives in 1995, representing the 10th District, serving as Sergeant-at-Arms beginning in 2002, and serving as Vice Chair of the Housing-Community Development-Social Services Committee and as a member of the Parks & Recreation, Public Safety & Health, and Transportation Committees; and

WHEREAS, Philip J. Giordano was elected a City Constable in 2004, a position he still holds; and is a former paid member of Stamford Fire & Rescue; and

WHEREAS, Philip J. Giordano has been a dedicated and active member of the larger Stamford community, serving with numerous organizations, including as a Board member of CTE and a member of the Oscar H. Cowan American Legion Post 3, Stamford, St. John's Basilica, the Holy Name Society, the J.M. Wright Technical School Citizens Advisory Committee, the West Side Business Council's Anti-Crime Vigil, and the United Way of Stamford Residential Division Team; graduated from the Stamford Citizens' Police Academy; and served as a coach with the American Legion Baseball League; and

WHEREAS, nothing has been more important to Philip J. Giordano than his family; he was married on November 7, 1975 to the late Marion A. Bottomly Santarsiero, and together they lived in Stamford and is dedicated to his numerous children, stepchildren, grandchildren, and great grandchildren.
