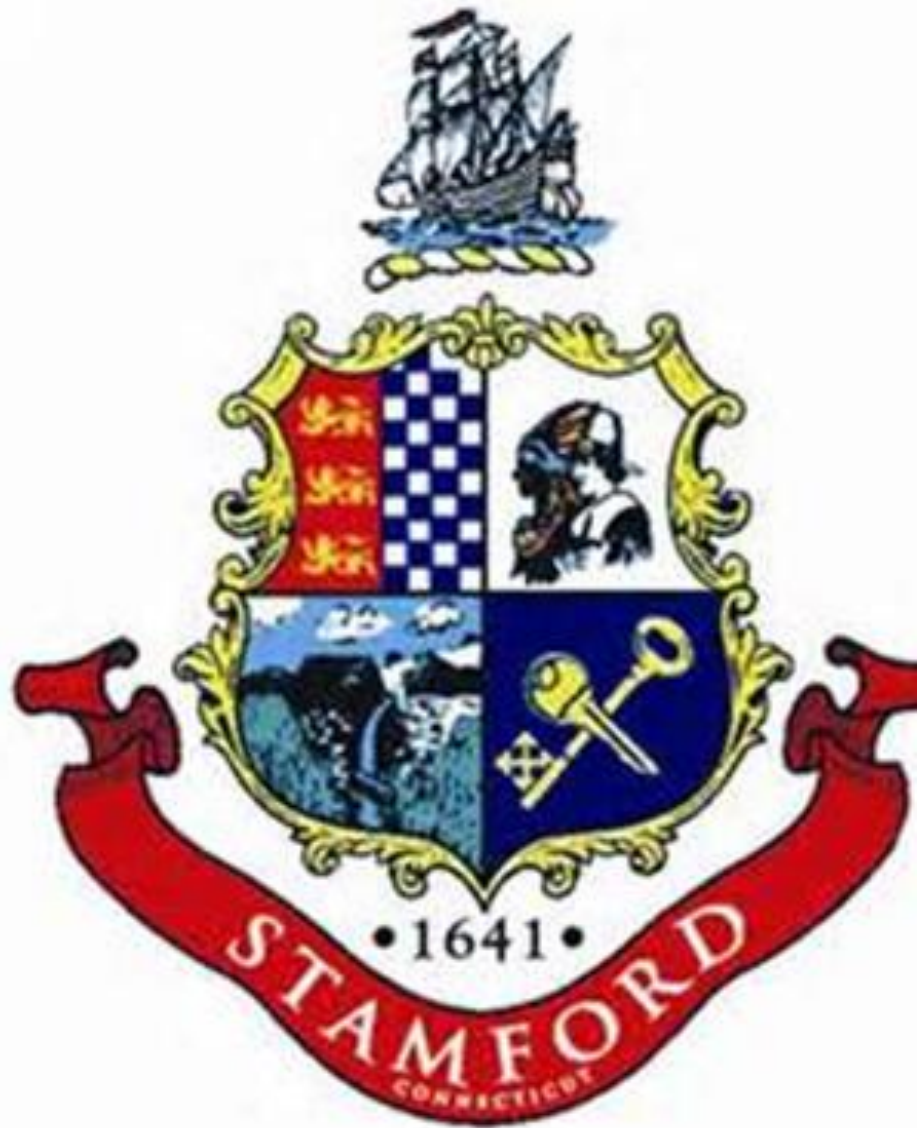

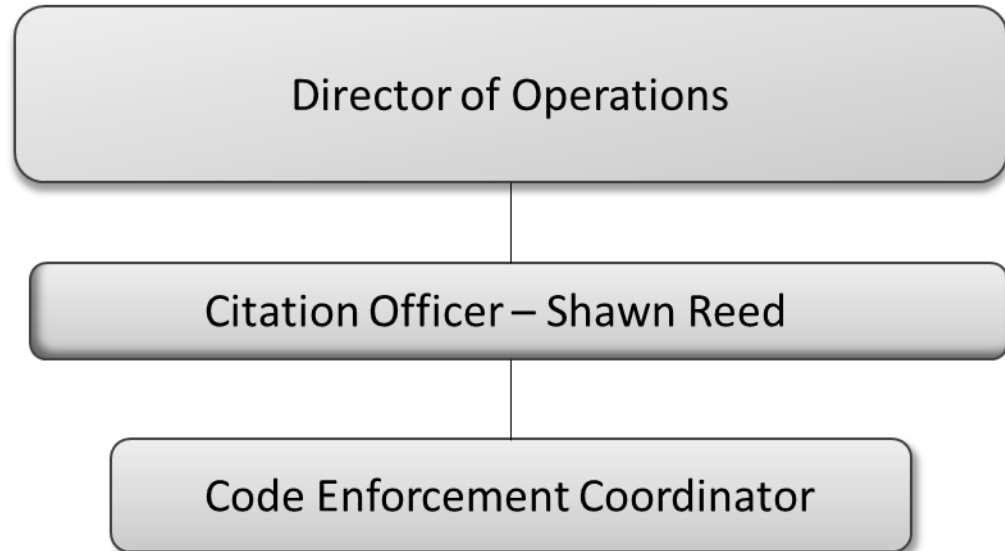

Budget Summary (FY 2025-26)

There are no new staffing changes to report. We are requesting an increase of \$25,000 to the 530006-Legal Expenses line item. With the implementation of the mayor's street to street initiative, we are expecting an increase in the number of blight cases being sent to our outside legal counsel.

New or Expanded Services/Programs (FY 2025-26)

1. We will participate in the Street-to-Street program by walking through selected areas to clean up and help maintain underserved neighborhoods.

Key Challenges & Changes (FY 2025-26)

The new street to street program will increase our workload. The last walk generated 24 new blight cases from just Stephen Street and Alden Street.

No new changes are expected.

Performance Improvements & Efficiencies:

- 1) We have changed our internal practices from creating paper files to making all blight cases digital. All new complaints from the past year are in our permitting system OpenGov and will transfer into Oracle when that system goes live.
- 2) Our budget will be balanced for the first time in 13 years.
