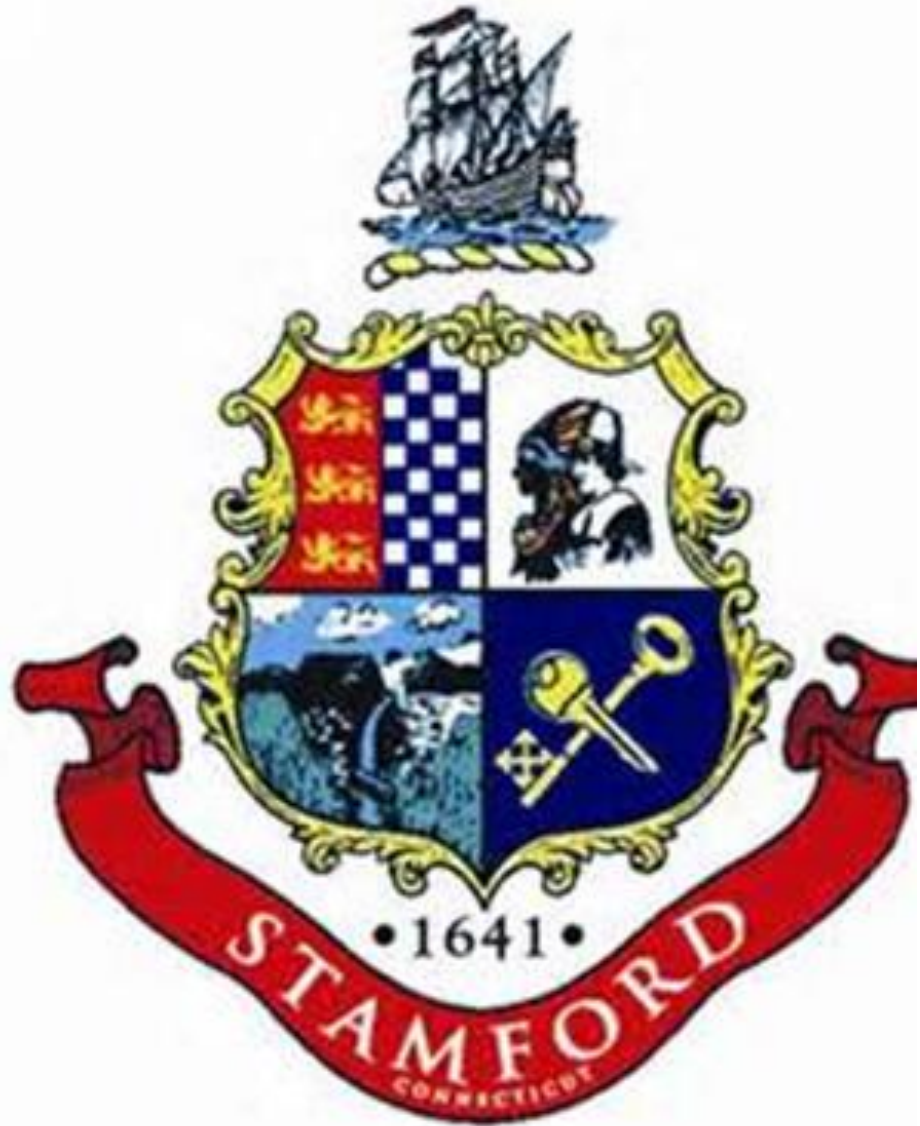


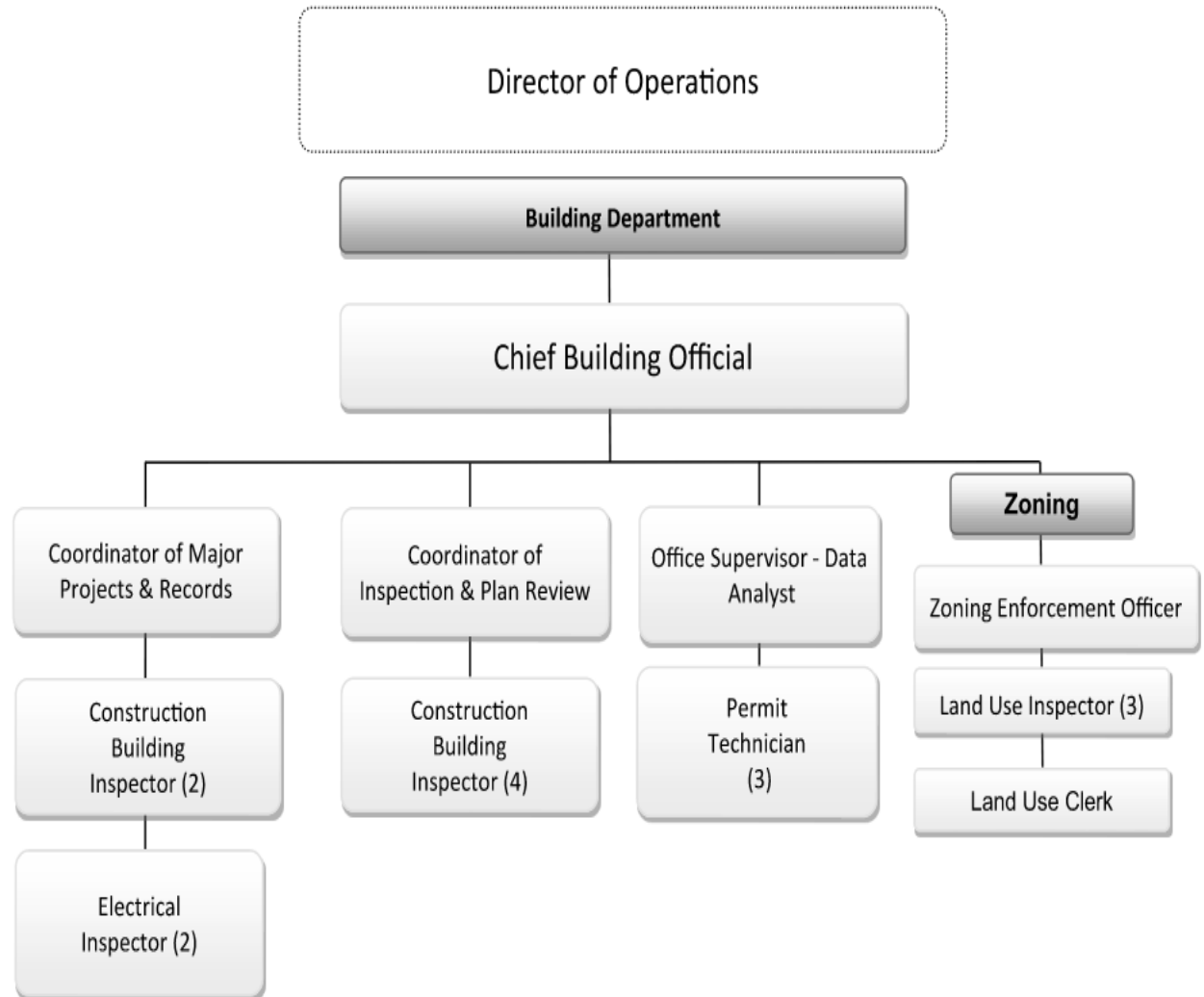

Departmental Challenges & Anticipated Changes:

Some challenges we will be facing are:

- 1) Launching of the new Oracle system will bring an adjustment period as the public and staff get used to it. An increased volume of emails, calls, meetings, and training sessions are expected from the public as well as other city departments.
- 2) An aging fleet system will affect our ability to do inspections as some cars will inevitably be out of service for repairs.
