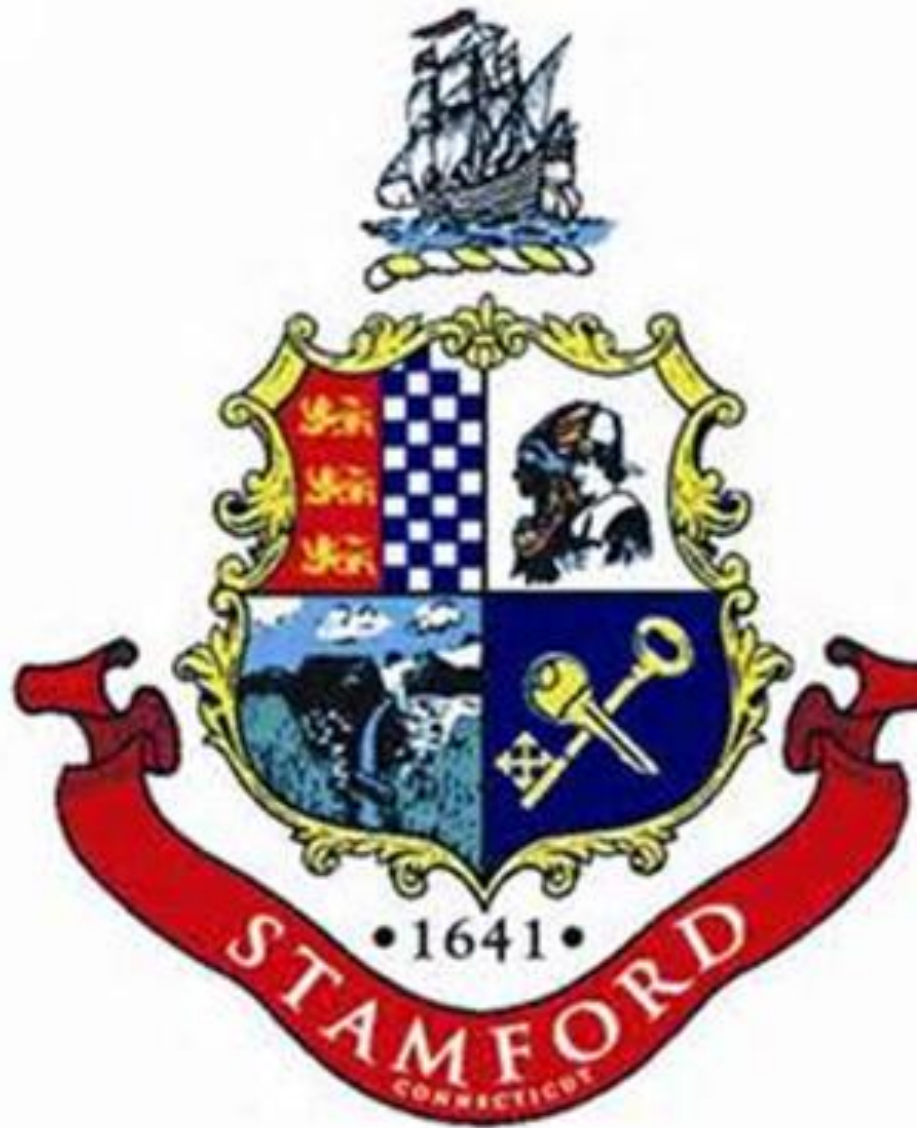

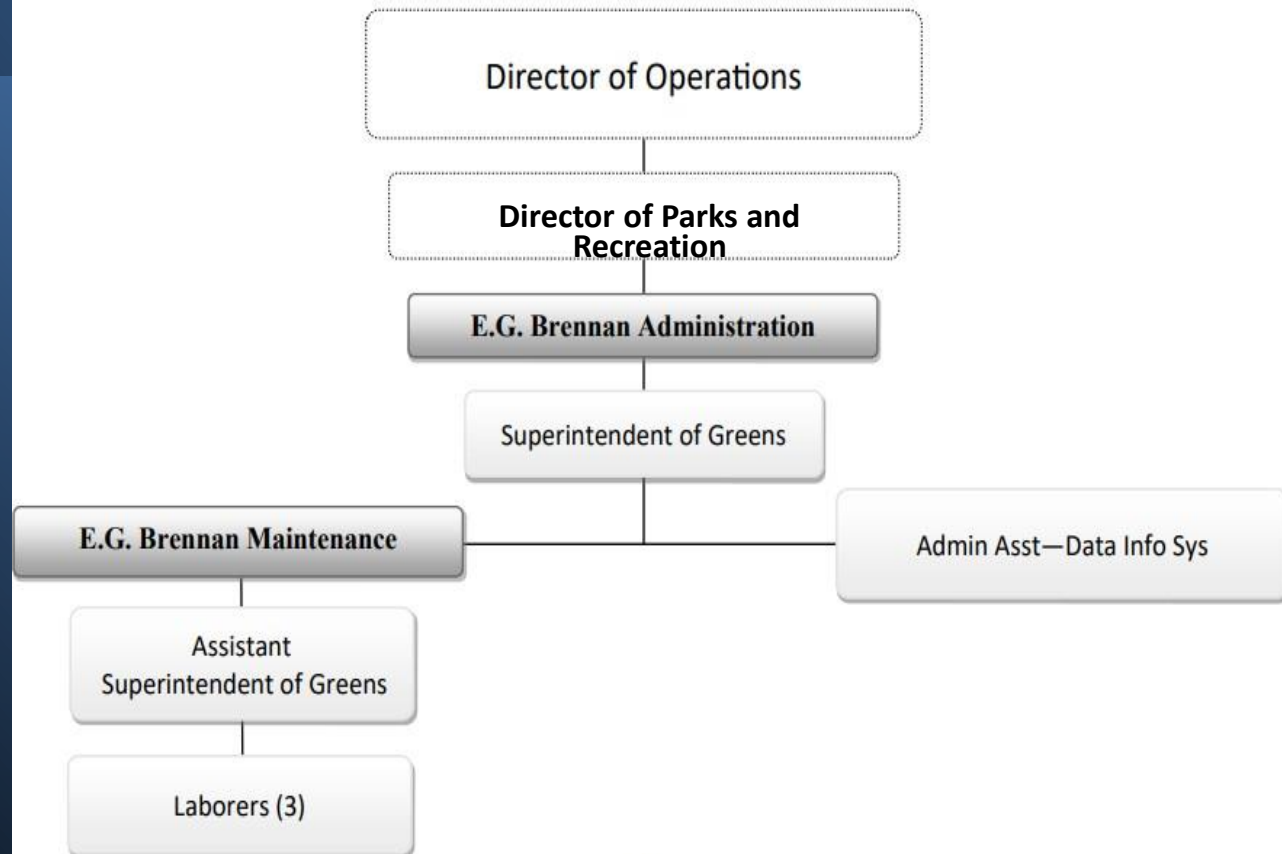
## Mission Statement

The Mission of E. Gaynor Brennan Municipal Golf Course is to provide the residents of Stamford and neighboring areas a preeminent public golf course. E. Gaynor Brennan is an 18 Hole Golf Course with a practice chipping/putting green, a full-service restaurant and clubhouse containing a golf simulator, lockers and golf shop. Amidst a competitive market for public golf the aim is for continually improving course conditions while being both fiscally responsible and environmentally mindful.

E. Gaynor Brennan operates as a self-sustaining entity with all of our expenses funded by revenues generated through user fees. No taxpayer funds are used in the operation of the Golf Course.

The Budget has remained flat except for costs outside of our control i.e. Contractually mandated increases and utilities. Additionally, Credit card fees have increased due to more customers using credit cards. Our revenue estimates for FY 25/26 is based on 39,500 player rounds compared with 39,000 rounds in FY 24/25.

## New or Expanded Services/Programs (FY 2025-26)

E. Gaynor Brennan Municipal Golf Course will be upgrading our Irrigation System. This will improve the course aesthetic appeal, maximize water delivery system, reduce waste, minimize repairs of our current system while saving labor.

We will be finalizing our contract with our Irrigation Consultant, who we will work with to help design the new irrigation layout of the course.

This project will not close the course, but we may need to close certain areas of the course for the safety of our golfers.

## Key Challenges & Changes (FY 2025-26)

E. Gaynor Brennan Municipal Golf Course purchased four new Electric Utility Vehicles replacing aging gas units.

We are looking to reassess our inventory to see what equipment we can replace next to align with the City's vision of a Greener Stamford.

E. Gaynor Brennan Municipal Golf Course has taken the initiative to explore organic options of products used on the golf course where we feel is deemed appropriate.

We are looking to collaborate this effort with various vendors that we use so we can see the same results from the current products that we use and see what products would be most cost efficient as well.

## Performance Improvements & Efficiencies:

E. Gaynor Brennan Municipal Golf Course is looking to upgrade their Thorguard System. This system is used for the detection of lightning and will alert the golfers on the course that lightning is in the vicinity and that they will need to exit the course and wait for a 30-minute period before returning to the course for play.

The golf course is looking to upgrade and improve our bunkers throughout the course. There will be some bunkers in the process that will be eliminated, and other bunkers will be improved with adding sand and removing access of rocks in the bunkers.
