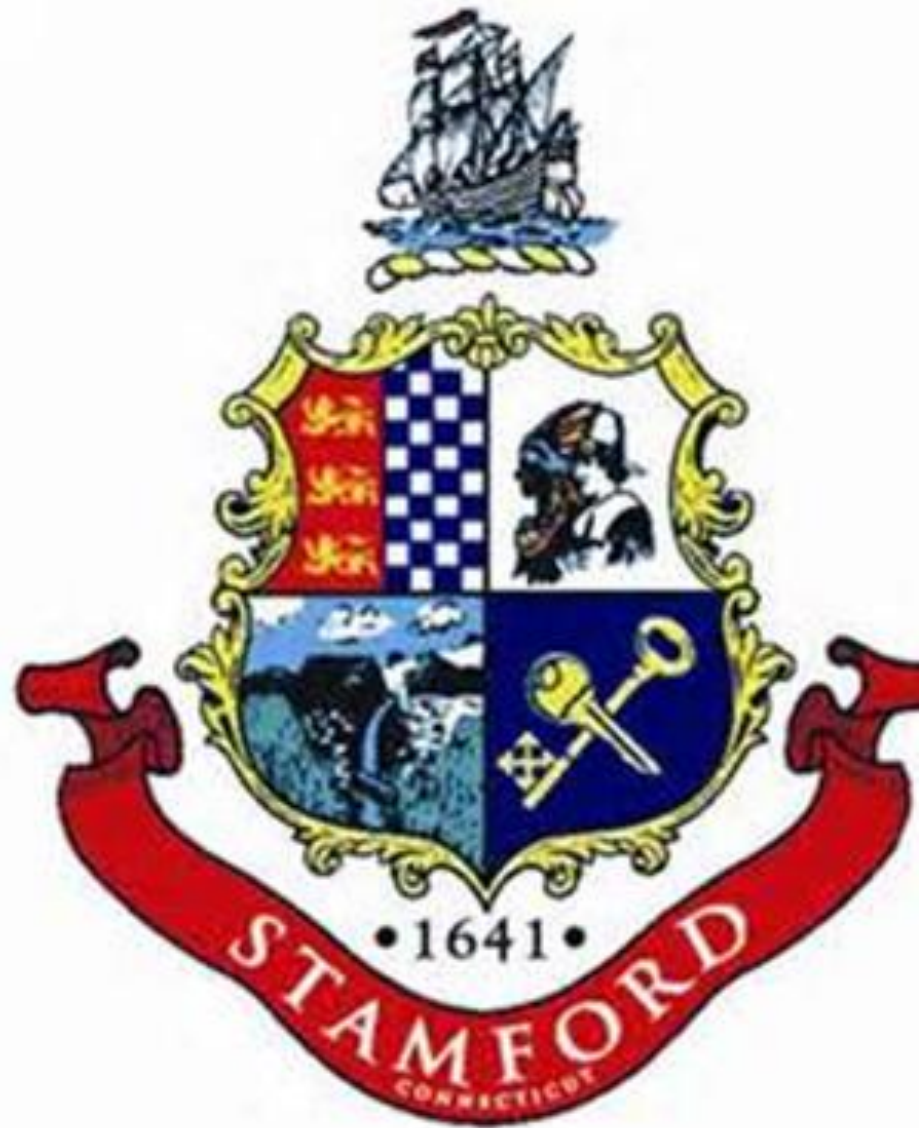
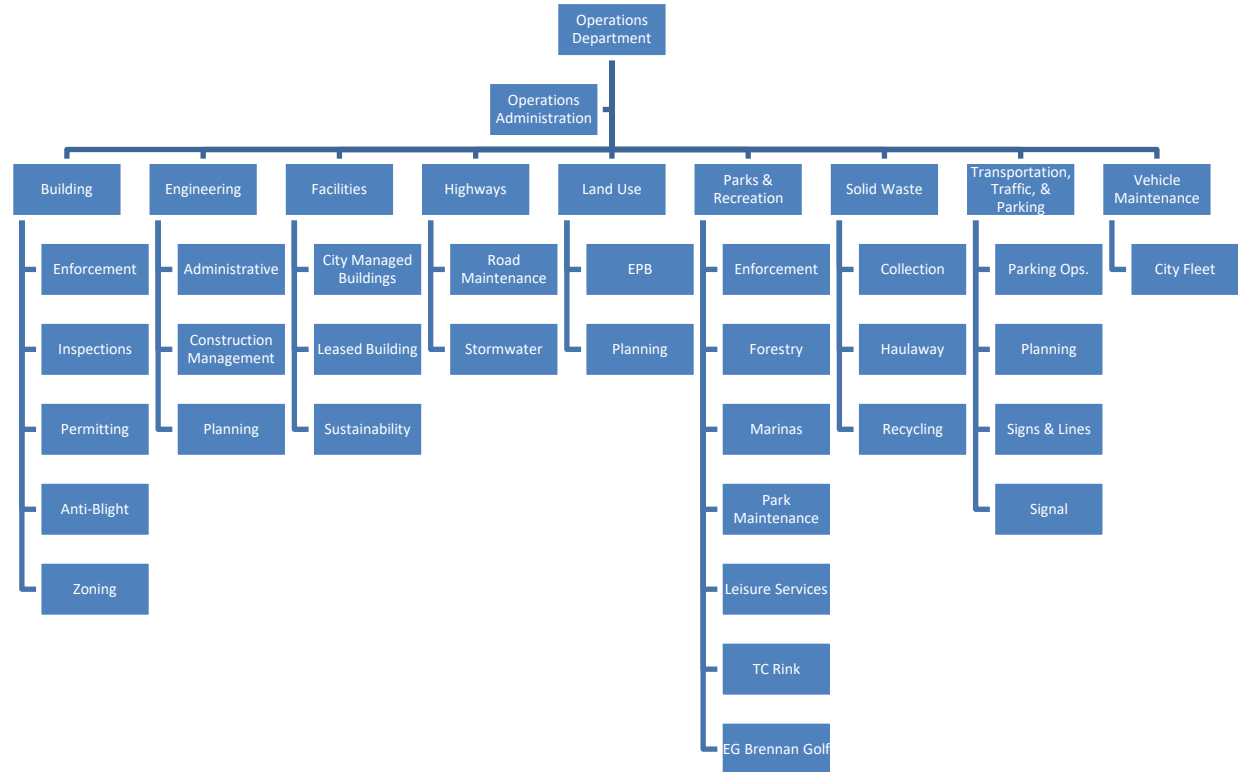

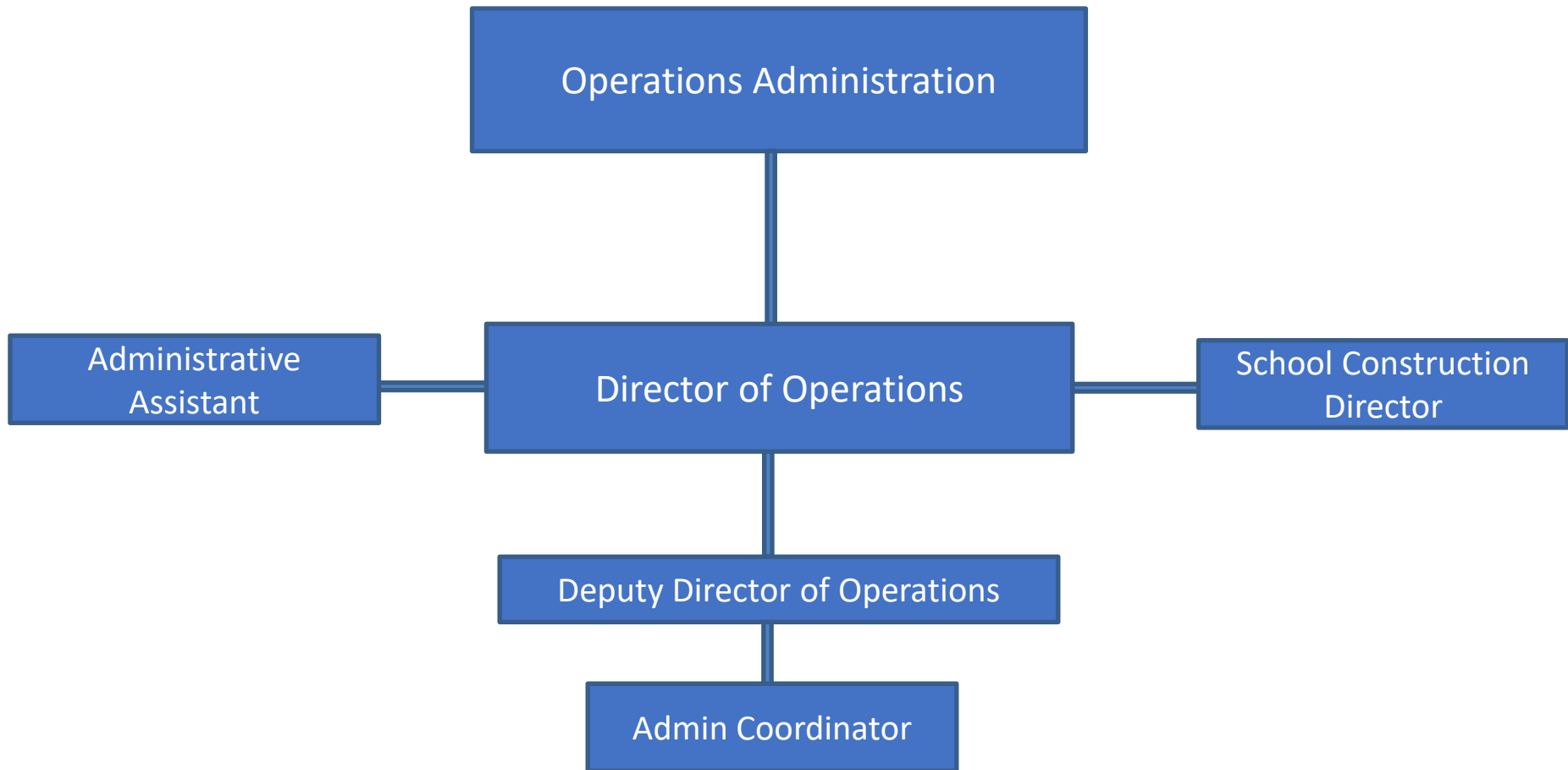
Department/Div. Organizational Chart
