Part A - Description of Request

There is currently no public boat launching facility on the Stamford Harbor shoreline. In pursuit of enhanced emergency and recreational access to the Stamford Harbor.

The Stamford Harbor Management Commission (SHMC) pursued and obtained a CT Port Authority, Small Harbor Improvement Projects Program (SHIPP) grant in 2022 to complete the Stamford Harbor Boat Launch Feasibility Study. Completed in February 2025, it found that the most suitable site is the northeastern side of Kosciuszko Park. In March, the City/SHMC received notice of award for a second SHIPP grant to complete a site evaluations and preliminary boat launch design.
