C. Whenever the Conservation Commission takes an action that shall require authorization by the Board of Representatives, said authorization given to the Commission by the Board of Representatives shall, promptly after its passage, be separately printed or typewritten, signed by the President, and attested by the Clerk who shall, within two (2) business days, present it to the Mayor. If the Mayor approves of such authorization, it shall be returned to the Clerk with written approval endorsed thereon and such authorization shall thereupon become effective ten (10) days after signature, unless a different effective date is specified in the authorization. If the Mayor disapproves the authorization, the Mayor shall, within ten (10) business days of receipt thereof, endorse the disapproval thereon and return it to the Clerk, and the Clerk shall promptly deliver the same with the Mayor's reasons for disapproval to the President of the Board, who shall in turn submit the same to the Board at its next regular meeting. The Board may, at the meeting or at any meeting held within forty (40) days thereafter, by two-thirds ( $\frac{2}{3}$ ) vote of the entire membership, pass the authorization over the Mayor's veto, and the authorization shall thereupon become effective without further action by the Mayor.
