

ORDINANCE NO. 1327
AMENDING ARTICLE III. STREET ACCEPTANCE SEC. 214-32
TO ALLOW THE CITY TO ACCEPT A PRIVATE ROAD BY ONLY REQUIRING
A PETITION SIGNED BY NO LESS THAN 2/3 (TWO-THIRDS) OF THE OWNERS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF STAMFORD THAT:

Article III. Street Acceptance of the City of Stamford Code of Ordinance be amended as follows:

Sec. 214-32. – Acceptance on petition.

Roads constructed within the city may be accepted as city streets by the governing body upon petition therefor by no less than **2/3 (two-thirds)** of the owners thereof.
