ORDINANCE TO DISSOLVE THE STAMFORD TRANSIT DISTRICT PER SECTION 59-8 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES WHEREAS, On September 7, 1993, the Board of Representatives adopted Chapter 59-Transit District as Ordinance No. 714; and WHEREAS, Section 59-8 provides that the district may be dissolved at any time by the Board of Representatives adopting an ordinance repealing Chapter 59; and WHEREAS, the transit district does not exercise the powers granted to the district stated in Section 59-4 and its only role is overseeing the maintenance and installation of bus shelters but the role of shelter oversight actually falls under the Transportation Department because the vendor for that work contracts with the City, not the transit district, which creates an inefficient bureaucratic delay at the expenses of the riding public; and WHEREAS, the repeal of Chapter 59-Transit District and the resulting dissolution of the Transit District will make the process for maintaining and installing bus shelters more efficient. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Representatives of the City of Stamford, pursuant to the authority granted in Section 59-8, hereby authorizes the establishment of the following ordinance: (Effective June 30, 2026) (a) Chapter 59-Transit District is hereby repealed.
